

HIA home display village largest in ACT, 'flying saucer' and all

The largest home display village put together by the Housing Industry Association in the ACT was opened in Sweet Place, Chisholm, yesterday by the Minister for Housing and Construction, Mr West.

The village comprises 16 homes by 13 of Canberra's major builders, and displays the latest in designs and building technology.

Central to the display is a "flying saucer" built on behalf of Canberra Building Society to provide home-loan and finance information and also to provide a diversion for

The ceiling of the "flying saucer" is a 360-degree representation of a lunar landscape.
