Subsequently, they returned to collect the white leather ball only to find it had disappeared.

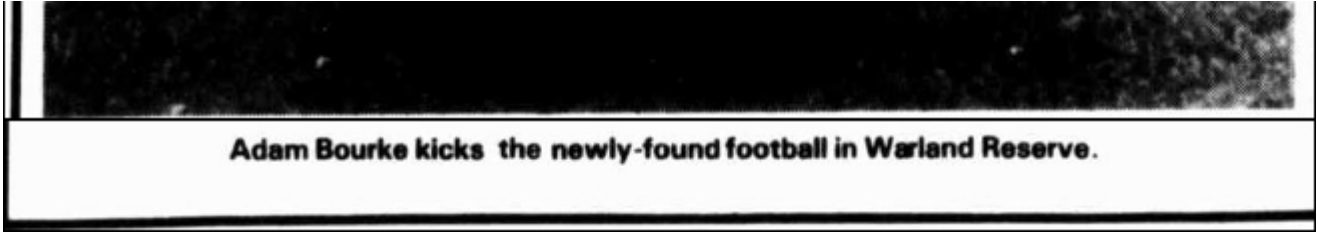
