

‘Four small human-like beings had been ejected’

Cover-up of aliens discovery claimed

A TOP level cover-up followed the discovery of four alien bodies in a crashed spacecraft, according to a document given to *The Daily Telegraph*.

UFO researchers claim details of the "human-like bodies" and their strange craft have been concealed for 30 years.

And a leading UFO author claimed in Sydney yesterday a number of other aliens have been discovered alive in their wrecked machines and stored in laboratories.

The document details a spacecraft crash in the US and the inquiry that followed.

It is said to have been written by Admiral Roscoe Hillenkoetter, the first CIA director and head of a secret committee, code-named Majestic-12.

The Admiral reported: "In late June, 1947... a local rancher reported that a spacecraft had crashed in a remote region of New Mexico, approximately 75 miles north-west of Roswell Army Air Force Base (now Walker Field).

"On July 1, a secret operation was begun to assure recovery of the wreckage. During the course of this operation, aerial reconnaissance discovered that four small human-like beings had apparently been ejected from the craft at some point before it exploded. All four were dead and badly decomposed.

"A special scientific team took charge of removing these bodies for

study. The wreckage of the craft was also removed.

"A covert analytical effort... on direct orders of the President (Truman) resulted in a preliminary consensus (AIC) (19 September 1947) that the disc was most likely a short-range reconnaissance craft.

Origin

"A similar analysis of the four dead occupants was arranged. It was the tentative conclusion of this group (30 November 1947) that although these creatures are human-like in appearance, the biological and evolutionary processes responsible for their development has apparently been quite different from those observed or postulated in homo-sapiens.

"Since it is virtually certain that these craft do not originate in any country on earth, considerable speculation has centred around what their point of origin might be and how they get here."

Sydney expert Bill Chalker, who has a world-wide reputation as a UFO researcher, said: "It's either the biggest hoax since the Hitler Diaries,

or a very interesting document."

Mr Chalker was the first civilian allowed direct access to RAAF UFO files.

"I have to emphasize there is nothing proven." British author Timothy Good is convinced the report is authentic.

Good, who arrived in Sydney this week to promote his bestseller, *Above Top Secret, the Worldwide UFO Cover-up*, claims the US have recovered other aliens - both dead and alive.

He claims to have seen pictures of what purported to be bodies of the humanoids. They had thin torsos and long arms.

A letter, reproduced in his book, written in 1963 by Dr Robert Barbscher, president of the Washington Institute of Technology says colleagues associated with recoveries of UFO craft in the fifties had given him the impression the alien bodies "were constructed like certain insects we have observed on earth."

ENGLISH author Tim Good, in Sydney to promote his book, *Above Top Secret, the Worldwide UFO Cover-up*, is pleased to see construction of the Opera House has finally been completed.
