

Bright lights in south-west

Four very bright orange lights were seen over Canberra's southern suburbs between 9pm and 9.25pm last night. Several people rang *The Canberra Times* and the lights were also reported to the police, the civil airport authorities and the RAAF base at Fairbairn.

An Oxley resident said they looked "the colour of orange street lights only very, very bright".

Another resident of Tuggeranong said he saw the lights in the south-west at about 9.20pm and they had faded by about 9.25pm. The lights appeared to be moving in formation and at first he thought they were RAAF helicopters, but they did not behave like normal aircraft.

The duty officer at RAAF could not say what the lights were but "they're usually aircraft".
