# People will soon meet aliens, claims Edgley

BRIGHT lights in Queensland skies on Friday night signalled the beginning of closer relations between UFOs and humans, a Nerang woman claimed yesterday.

Jeni Edgley, of Hide-away Farm, said the sightings were in line with the prophecies of Bashar, whom she said was an entity from another world. Bashar was channelled by an American medium at the farm two weeks ago.

Ms Edgley, the former wife of showbiz entrepreneur Michael Edgley, said

Bashar had said the sightings would probably begin on October 17 and continue through to next year

during which time some people would meet aliens.

Last night about 30 people on the farm searched the night sky for the lights which appeared at 9pm on Friday across South-East Queensland and the NSW coast.

Lismore Police received 40 calls in the 20 minutes after the sightings from people believing they had seen UFOs.

Astronomer Mike Smith said the lights were more likely to be a sporadic meteor shower.

He said it was unlikely

to be the result of dust from Halley's Comet or the Gemini constellation which travel across the sky this time of year because it was still too early.

Dust as small as a pea could create an enormous trail of light, he said, because of the speed at which it travelled.
