

Reports of UFO at Tulka

PORT Lincoln police were kept busy on Saturday night searching for unidentified flying objects.

A police spokeswoman said two separate reports of strange lights in the sky were made to police on Saturday night.

The spokeswoman said a UFO, described as an object with a large light suspended beneath it, was seen at Tulka, about 10 kilometres south of Port Lincoln, at around 6.50 pm.

She said a second object, seen from Winter Hill two hours later, was reported to have moved slowly across the sky in a zig-zagging fashion.

A member of the International Committee for UFO Research Judith Magee said the reports sounded similar to a number of recent hoaxes.

Mrs Magee said a new children's toy, which when ignited floated into the air like a hot-air balloon, had been responsible for many fake reports Australia wide.

"These balloons just float across the sky and don't do anything particularly unusual," Mrs Magee said.

"They have been a bit of a nuisance lately."
