

# On the trail of a UFO

Did you see a bright light streaking across the sky at dusk on June 6?

If you did Victorian UFO Research Society (VUFORS) sightings and investigations officer Paul Norman wants to hear from you.

Mr Norman is researching the sighting of an object that appeared at 5.35pm near Bairnsdale and travelled across the sky in a western direction before disappearing near Ballarat five minutes later. "It was too fast for a jet but slower than a meteor," he said.

Mr Norman said the item has been described as cylinder shaped with a trail of bright light.

It also displays sparks of flame which Mr Norman said would have been static electricity, believed to be a common feature of UFOs.

Mr Norman said he had received hundreds of sightings and had interviewed people in Geelong, Colac and Warrnambool, with Benalla presenting the closest view.

While the sightings had been good, they were taken from the south looking north, he said.

Mr Norman said he had come to Echuca to find some people who had witnessed the object from the north.

This would allow him to get a better understanding of the size of the object, he said.

“If I keep getting sightings from the south, I’ll have to go into country NSW,” he said.

The VUFORS was formed in 1957 with the aim of researching UFOs in a scientific way.
