

'Spectacular light' over Tmba

More than one UFO may have rained down on Australia this week.

A "spectacular light" was seen in the skies over Toowoomba on

Monday night.

Observers believe the falling object may have been a cosmic colleague of the outer-space visitor which landed near Guyra, in northern New South Wales, earlier this week.

During an after-dinner stroll along Hume Street on Monday, Mrs Leonie Jackel and her husband Klaus saw a light moving in a north-westerly direction about 8pm.

"It was like a big star in the front with a huge tail which only lasted for a few seconds," Mrs Jackel said.

"I remember trying to see Halley's Comet by spending hours looking through binoculars.

"This was closer than a normal shooting star and it disappeared in the sky."
