MPs betray UFO hacker

UK Labour MPs were accused of hypocrisy after abandoning autistic Pentagon hacker Gary McKinnon in his fight against extradition to the US.

Seventy-four MPs who pledged their written support failed to vote against the Government's refusal to try him in the UK on charges of computer misuse.

McKinnon admits hacking into NASA and Pentagon computers looking for evidence of UFOs.

The vote allows McKinnon to be taken to the US for trial, where he faces up to 60 years' jail.

Lawyers fear this could lead to a possible breakdown and suicide because of his condition.
