Aliens try out nukes

A group of retired US air force officers are claiming that UFOs have been tampering with American nuclear weapons.

The six former officers, and one other enlisted man, will break their silence on the alien intervention in Washington tomorrow and urge the US government to come clean on the issue.

Robert Hastings, the author of *UFOs and Nukes* says the veterans will present evidence of how missiles inexplicably malfunctioned while disc-shaped objects hovered nearby.

"As unbelievable as it may seem to some, UFOs have long monitored and sometimes tampered with our nukes," he said.

ICBM launch officer Captain Robert Salas claims to have wit-

nessed a UFO incident in 1967 which caused a missile disruption at an air base in Montana.

He, like the others, says he was ordered to keep quiet.

"The Air Force is lying about the national security implications of unidentified aerial objects at nuclear bases, and we can prove it," he said.

The UK government has also been accused of covering it up.

Meanwhile, if the aliens ever land on Earth there'll no longer be any confusion over who greets them, with the United Nations appointing an astrophysicist to be their first human contact.

Mazlan Othman, a 58-year-old Malaysian, is set to be tasked with co-ordinating humanity's response to an alien visit.
