

Kids seek help for alien fears

CHILDREN as young as three are seeing an "alien abduction counsellor" over fears they have had extraterrestrial encounters.

Worried parents are shunning doctors and turning to Sunshine Coast grandmother Mary Rodwell, the self-described "alien lady", after their children exhibited "paranormal" symptoms.

Ms Rodwell claims to have counselled more than 1700 people from around the world, including many children.

She said children and adults shared similar recollections of being taken into spacecraft and scrutinised by aliens.

University of Queensland Associate Professor William Grey, who has studied paranormal belief, said there was no doubt these experiences were real in people's minds.
