

# Pilot spots drone

The FBI says it is investigating the sighting of a small unmanned aircraft near New York's John F. Kennedy International Airport, and has asked the public for help locating its operator. Described as black in colour and no more than 90 centimetres wide with four propellers, the plane came within 61-metres on Monday of an Alitalia jet that was making its final approach to land at JFK, the FBI said. The Federal Aviation Administration said the sighting was reported by the pilot of the Alitalia jet. He said the craft was six to eight kilometres south-east of the airport "at an altitude of approximately 1500 feet (450 metres)," the FAA said. It added the pilot did not take evasive action and the Alitalia jet landed safely.
