

SHY SPACEMEN SPY ON US

SPACE-SHIP captains from other planets have been watching the earth for 12 years, according to an organisation calling itself the "World Interplanetary Association" which has just ended its Third Congress in Geneva.

A communique stated that "proof has been accumulating that beings more evolved than ourselves survey the earth continually, alerted especially by atomic explosions and our plans for space travel."

The Association says that "the occupants of these space-ships are shy and are delaying large-scale interplanetary contacts because of their fear of being seen during the landing of flying-saucers."
