THE 'THINGS'
THAT ARE SEEN
IN THE SKY...

ON April 3, 1964, an unmanned Gemini spacecraft was successfully launched from Cape Kennedy—formerly Cape Canaveral—Florida.

As the Gemini went into the position for the orbital flight, the tracking gear began picking up additional objects.

Four circular "things" came streaking in from space and positioned themselves around the Gemini.

Two of the objects were directly above the space capsule, one was below it, another behind it. And these unidentified flying objects — UFOs — held those positions around the Gemini while it made one complete orbit of the earth.

As it approached Florida again, the UFOs left it and zipped back out into space.

Newsmen were not permitted to mention the incident in their reports. Fortunately, some foreign scientists, who had been watching the fantastic event on the tracking gear, and who were not subject to American censorship, did mention the incident.

Inquisitive

This is not the first time that an American spacecraft has been paced by a UFO. On January 10, 1961, a Polaris missile launched from what was then Cape Canaveral was approached and paced by a UFO that was so large that the tracking gear automatically shifted over to the UFO.

When the inquisitive UFO paced the Polaris, it took 14 minutes for the radar operators to get their gear off the UFO and back on the launch site, Polaris.

It happened again in May 1962, when several Australians reported seeing a large, glowing object moving across the sky with a pronounced wobble. Then a smaller object appeared, tracked the whole object, which promptly ceased to wobble. Its two of them then tracked upwards and disappeared in the heavens.

Dr. Paul Slupe, Science Officer at the American

embassy in Canberra and two American scientists, investigated. They came to the conclusion that the witnesses had seen what they reported, but they declined to offer any possible identification of the objects.

All around the world, important military installations report "visits" by Unidentified Flying Objects. What the things are, what they want, where they come from, no one knows — or is it a well-kept secret?
