Sky watchers ³⁴⁰⁴ plan big day

A national sky watch for unidentified objects will be kept on June 24, exactly 20 years after a United States pilot reported nine gleaming discs over Mount Ranier in the state of Washington.

The watch will be kept by members of the British Unidentified Flying Object Research Association.

Their mobile investigation unit will be stationed "in an area of peak sightings of unidentified flying objects," to be determined just before the watch starts.
