# Two PCs book 3404 flying saucer

Two police constables have sent in an official report about a flying saucer. And yesterday their chief superintendent, after interrogating both men, allowed the report to be released.

Lionel Haw and Steve Parsonage, both stationed at Hindley, near Wigan, sighted their saucer early last Thursday morning.

Police-constable Parsonage, aged 20, said last night, "I have never believed stories of people seeing flying saucers, but now I have seen one myself.

"I was on the beat when I glanced up and saw this object in the sky. It was glowing white. I could not believe my eyes.

"Then I saw Police-constable Haw driving a patrol car towards me. I waved him to stop, and we stood looking at it when it suddenly started to move."

Constable Haw, who has been in the force eight years, said, "We watched it move across the sky for two minutes. It certainly was not a comet, weather balloon, plane or trick of light.

"In this job you are trained to observe. We had time to have a good look at it. I would estimate its size as well over 100 feet in diameter."
