

UFO over Hoad

3604 **C**OULD this be a space-craft from some far-off part of the universe, or is it just some kind of balloon?

For this is a photograph of the UFO (unidentified flying object or objects) that caused such a stir on Sunday morning.

Mr. J. Monks, of 7 Skiddaw Gardens, Hawcoat, Barrow, took this picture at 10.30 a.m. as he started the ascent to the Hoad Monument at Ulverston. "It was almost certainly a balloon," Mr. Monks told me. "The main spherical portion seemed to



be draped in a transparent envelope, in order to support the lower part probably.

"What seems rather odd about this is the fact that it neither moved away nor changed altitude as would a free balloon."

The photograph was taken with a Manniga Seker 500 TL SLR f2 camera with a Seker 135 mm lens using orange filter.

The image from the negative was projected on 0.250 Kodak Ortho plate.

"Unfortunately," says Mr. Monks, "the transparent parts of the object have been completely lost in processing, and only the roughest idea of its shape can be gained from the photographs."
