# Boys sight mystery 'craft'

The South Wales Argus has been given a description of a strange object said to have been seen high to the east of Blackwood by four schoolboys on Tuesday night.

The boys are Vivian Watson, 15; Haydn Davies, nine; David Fleet, eleven; and his brother, Dennis Fleet, 14. They live in the Attlee Road area.

They say the object was seen in the east at about 8 p.m. It was round and silver-coloured. It was circling around in the sky, then it stopped suddenly, went straight up and disappeared.

Mrs. T. Fleet told the South Wales Argus on Thursday that David was the first to see the object. He called Dennis and asked him: "What is that up there?"

Mrs. Fleet said she did not see the object, but David and Dennis thought it might be a flying saucer.

Mrs. Fleet said Dennis was very interested in astronomy, and had books and charts on the subject.
