

UFO over N. Wales?

Sir,—It would be interesting to know if any other people witnessed the passage of a most unusual body in the skies at 4.40 am on Wednesday, March 5.

The craft, or object, was brilliant white, elongated like a cigar which could easily have been a saucer seen edgeways, and appeared suddenly out of the blackness of the night sky, having no streaming trail behind it.

Its speed was much faster than an aircraft, yet certainly not so fast as to be mistaken for a meteorite. Its line of flight was from south to north, and was directly over and parallel with the length of Nant-y-Gamar mountain range. Its disappearance was as sudden as its appearance had been. There was a sudden cutting-out of the intense whiteness, just as if the brilliance had suddenly been switched off. Its flight path had been perfectly straight and not arced.
