Two more UFOs are reported seen

FURTHER sightings of a UFO in the Port Talbot area have been reported today.

Two Aberavon steelworkers, who were fishing near the Tidal Harbour on Saturday evening, Mr. Cliff Dudley aged 40, of Verdi Road, Sandfields, and Mr. Terry Crowley, of Farm Drive, Sandfields, claim they saw the unidentified object five times in the space of an hour between 6 and 7 p.m.

Mr. Dudley said: "On the first two occasions it was just like a flash of light travelling in the first instance from the West going across Swansea Bay towards Porthewl and then in the reverse direction.

"The third time it was below low cloud travelling more slowly and was an oval fluorescent shape. On the fourth and fifth occasions it was too fast to distinguish any shape."

AND AT KILLAY

Mr. Dudley added: "I had not reported it before but having read of sightings of UFOs in the area I thought it right to report what we saw as it might help anyone investigating to set some pattern to whatever is happening."

A UFO has also been sighted over Killay, Swansea, this week.

It was seen by three adults and four youngsters on Monday evening in the same evening that two UFOs were reported over Neath.

Mr. Bob Morse, of Goetre Faw Road, Dunvant, described it as having two red lights and occasionally emitting a blue arc from the bottom. He said that with the aid of binoculars, it could be seen to be spinning as it travelled.

It was silent and moved in an arc from Killay towards Three Croases.
