UFO sighting at Cross Keys reported

A UFO sighting at Cross Keys has been reported by two women.

Mystery lights were seen in the sky above the Tredegar Arms pub by Mrs. Dorothy Jones, of Blackwood, and her sister-in-law, Mrs. Sandra Jones, of Brynawel.

Both women said they saw the twin lights on Friday at about 11 p.m.

"They were a bit like car headlamps but they seemed to be suspended in the air. I am sure it wasn't an aeroplane because the lights were quite low and we would have heard something," said Mrs. Dorothy Jones. "Neither of us had been drinking and we watched the lights for several minutes before driving off."

Her sister-in-law was driving the car and she too said she had seen strange lights.

"I thought it was car headlights, too, but there were no mountains in the area near where the lights were," she said.

A group of people gathered outside the public house to watch the lights, which were moving very

slowly across the sky, added the two women.

Gwent police said they had not received any reports of UFO sightings and a spokesman at Cardiff (Wales) Airport said it was impossible to say whether there were any aircraft in the area.
