## 'We also saw mystery object,' say family

ANOTHER sighting of the UFO which frightened a Gwent family at the weekend has been reported to the *Argus*.

And the second family to be transfixed by the mystery object in the sky are equally baffled by their close encounter of the weird kind.

Mrs Lorraine Anslow, her husband Terry and their children, Stephen, 21, and Ellen, 17, saw the object near their home at Goldcliff, near Nash, Newport.

Their sighting was at about the same time as the Davies family, of Penllwyn, Pontllanfraith, whose story appeared in the *Argus* on Saturday. They had seen what they could only describe as a UFO at Bedwellty Mountain, near Blackwood.

The Anslow family, too, can offer no explanation for what they saw. Mrs Anslow said the large object was hovering at about 1,000 to 1,500 feet in the sky.

It had green and red lights which were very bright and they said the lights were too close together to have been a plane. The object was not moving and, like the Davies family, they said it was making no noise.

"We were not really frightened, but we wondered what on earth it was," said Mrs Anslow. It was only when we read about the other family seeing it that we realised we had seen the same thing."

There is still no official explanation of what the object was — so the mystery continues . . .
