Light flash search

A SEARCH which started when two people reported seeing a flash of light on a Cynon Valley mountain has been called off, police say.

The alert started on the evening of March 15, when police at Aberdare received two telephone calls reporting a flash of light on the mountain between Mountain Ash and Aberaman.

A search of the area was carried out that evening despite severe weather conditions. RAF helicopters from

West Wales and Devon were called in to help.

Checks with the Civil Aviation Authority showed that no aircraft were reported missing, but police with dogs made a further search of the area on Thursday.

Chief Inspector Keri Humphries, of Aberdare police, said nothing was found in the search and the inquiry has now been called off.
