# Scorched circles: Expert will probe farm UFO link

AN EXPERT on UFOs is to visit a farm where mysterious scorched circles have appeared in the grass.

Mrs Margaret Fry lives a few miles from Voel Farm, Llanfair T.H., Abergel, but is now staying in Sussex.

She is the Wales representative of

BUFORA — the British Unidentified Flying Object Research Association.

Mrs Fry, of Llan-gernyw, said: "This is most exciting.

"Obviously I do not know what caused the circles, but want to research them, and take soil samples.

"I will be back home on Tuesday, and plan to see for myself."

Mrs Pat Coulson of Voel Farm has no idea what caused the triangle of circles on her 33 acre mixed farm 900 feet up on the Denbigh Moors.

She spotted them a few weeks ago, but said

nothing for a time because she thought people would laugh.

The circles are now fading, but can still be seen.

There has been no explanation for circles of flattened crops which have also appeared in cornfields in the West Country in recent years, but many people are convinced they were caused by flying saucers landing.

Mrs Fry says she is at present looking into a sighting of a strange object by three motorists near Bala on January 11 this year.

"There had been some unusual sightings on the Denbigh Moors, and in one case a farmer was chased to his door by a UFO, but had been reluctant to discuss what happened."
