existence of alien beings. His research has taken him around the world where he has amassed a bizarre collection of stories - the most out of this world being that America has been test-flying UFOs in the Nevada Desert.

An intelligent, quietly-spoken man, he is a recognised authority on the subject and frequently gives lectures on extra-terrestrial activity - including talks to the Institute of Medical Laboratory Sciences and the House of Lords. In his latest book, *Alien Liaison*, Tim cites only credible sources of information, such as high-ranking military personnel.

Until now, the US government has kept suspiciously quiet about its findings. Tim Good believes this is to protect national security. "The material used in the propulsion unit could be made into a super bomb," he has been told.

Furthermore, it is believed the government has in its possession an alien craft and a body of one of the occupants. This sensational evidence of life beyond earth has so far been kept under wraps

accounts of recovered UFOs and their alien occupants being in the hands of the United States Government agencies are not true, then many important people have lied . . . since they are all named by Tim Good in this book they must now either put up or shut up."

Good has evidence of "an extremely high intelligence" among alien visitors. "Their technology is so advanced they can manipulate gravity. As a result, time shrinks to nil. Places which are light years away, which would take a human lifetime and more to get to, can be reached within a matter of hours.

"They live considerably longer than us but there is nothing strange about that. Just compare our average lifespan now that medical technology has advanced, with the lifespan of someone living in the 16th century."

Tim Good has never had a close encounter himself, but he has spotted UFOs on a number of occasions. The ultimate excitement for him would be to joyride in an alien craft himself . . .
