Light work of faults

ELECTRICITY chiefs are urging members of the public not to panic if they see flashing white lights in the sky around South Wales.

They are not UFOs but devices to show if there is a fault on overhead electricity lines.

SWALEC bosses are hoping that they will help engineers locate problems and restore power far sooner than they were able to before.

Alan Mathews, SWALEC's mains development manager, said: "Four hundred fault indicators are being put in place every year and we hope that in seven years' time they will be in use throughout South Wales."
