# If an alien force takes over, author Guy's the man to call

Within a matter of days, Britain will be under attack from a fleet of massive spaceships. It could happen here . . . and probably will.

Independence Day, a film which has broken all box office records with the most successful opening ever, is released in cinemas here on August 9.

Great cities all over our planet are devastated as an alien force takes over - and it's proving to be hugely popular.

America is in the grip of UFO fever following Independence Day's launch on July 4, and it's sure to set a few eyes gazing up into the skies here too.

Many people claim to have spied unidentified objects, and, anxious at the reaction they may get, many of them choose to say nothing about it.

But from now on, if you live in Mid Wales, we know a man who can help.

Guy N. Smith, who lives near Knighton, is better known as a writer of horror fiction and books about wildlife. But he is starting to collate information about UFO sightings in this area.

"I am really interested to see what comes out of this," said Guy. "I think you should never close your mind to anything."

He has been asked to pass on any reports he receives to the Birmingham UFO Society.

"If someone has a sighting, they needn't name themselves," said Guy. He has simple forms from the society for people to fill in giving date, time and location.

"I am really collecting information and passing it on to the society," he said.

"They're trying to form patterns - back in the 60s people

were seeing flying saucers, now it's triangular crafts."

"Apparently UFOs home in on rural areas, and until now, no-one has collated any detail of sightings over this part of the country.

"They undoubtedly do like rural areas as they seem to take an interest in animals as well as people," said Guy.

Representatives of the Birmingham UFO Society are planning a visit to Knighton soon, and the next issue of Guy's fan club magazine, Graveyard Rendezvous is to feature the subject of UFOs.

"Anybody who wants to contact me about a sighting should do so as soon as they can - an immediate phone call would be very helpful."
