# UFO sighted in Brecon skies

Strange lights in the night sky have been seen several times during the past three weeks in the Brecon area. Local man, Mr. Tom Reynolds, walking home with his son on Saturday 29th March at 10.30 pm was amazed to see a multicoloured object thirty degrees above the horizon in the south west to the right of Pen-y-Fan. "We were admiring the Hale-Bopp comet and turned to look at Orion. The object was flashing all sorts of different colours, brighter than Mars, and through my binoculars I could see separate lights including blue, red, green and

purple, quite different from aircraft lights. The object was visible in the same place on the following two nights. Chronicle astronomy correspondent Alex Gibbon says: "I've also been observing that part of the sky and seen nothing unusual. The object is therefore likely to have been relatively close to Brecon. From Mr Reynolds' description it does not appear to have been the bright star Sirius and the main candidates would be a high-altitude weather balloon, something military - or indeed, the activities of aliens".
