Mysterious UFO man fighting for his life

DOCTORS say a mystery man, who has been unconscious in hospital for almost a month, is now fighting for his life.

Police and hospital staff in Swindon, Wiltshire, have no idea who the patient is 24 days after he was found unconscious at the town's railway station.

Now they say his condition is deteriorating and they are desperate to trace his next of kin.

Yesterday, a spokeswoman for Swindon's Princess Margaret Hospital described his condition as "critical".

She said, "It has now been 24 days since he was found and although we have had some response to our appeals we seem no closer to finding out who he is.

"His condition has deteriorated and we really need to find his next of kin.

"He had no identification papers of any kind on him but he does have a very distinctive UFO tattoo on his arm."

As well as the tattoo on his upper left arm the man was also carrying books about aliens and the paranormal in a rucksack.

Other books and maps in the bag indicate he could have been walking in North Wales shortly before he was found.

The hospital cannot release details of what injuries or condition doctors are treating him for without the agreement of his next of kin.
