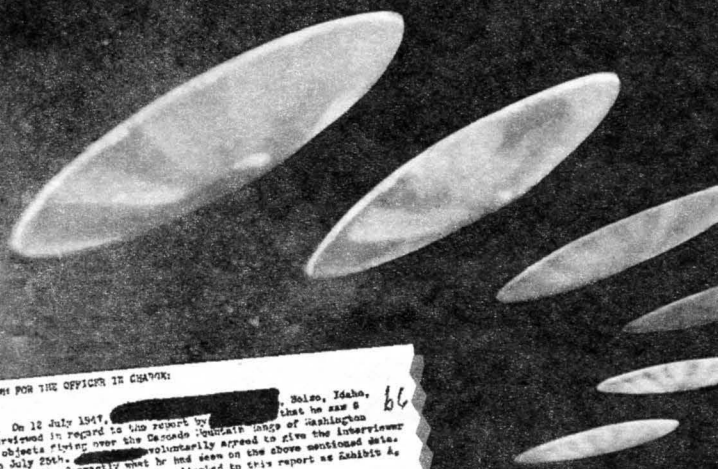

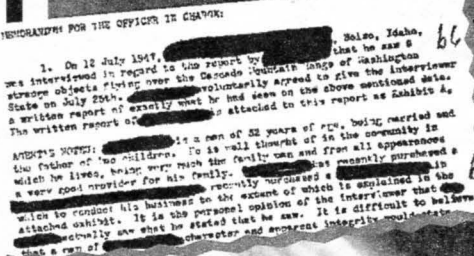

First X-Files case — how it all got started



WELL-RESPECTED, sober family man Kenneth Arnold could never have imagined he would fly his light airplane into the strangest pages of still unexplained mystery on a clear June day in 1947.
Flying normally above the Cascade range near Mt. Rainier, Wash., Arnold couldn't believe his eyes when he saw nine dark-colored saucer-shaped discs racing near him at speeds the veteran pilot estimated at over 1,000 mph, executing maneuvers no aircraft could withstand.
Arnold reported the unnerving incident to family and friends, and within days, newspapers around the world carried stories of his hair-raising experience.
FBI agents interrogated Arnold for hours, then filed a detailed report to FBI headquarters.
And the X-Files were born.
Other sightings followed, and in 1948 Air Force General Nathan Twining created a unit called Project Saucer, which was changed to Project Sign, then later Project Grudge — a group with a new mission.
They set out to convince Americans they had nothing to fear from UFOs. They dismissed even the most spectacular sightings as atmospheric disturbance, weather balloons, swamp gas, reflections by ordinary aircraft — even hailstorm showers.

Harvard prof confirms alien abductions

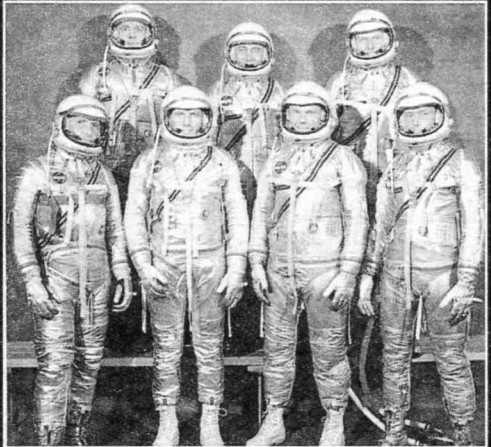


Dr. John Mack: "The evidence is totally persuasive"

NO episodes of the X-Files are more chilling than those in which agents Mulder and Scully are seized in close encounters of the worst kind — contacts with aliens from other worlds.
Some are here for the purpose of aiding our planet, others to study — and possibly dissect — us as if we were a curious species.

Budd Hopkins has studied alien abduction for 20 years. In his book, *Missing Time*, he details one horrifying case of a suburban Indianapolis housewife named Kathie Davis whose incredible encounters with aliens began when she was a child.
Davis was told by her ET visitors that they would one day return — which they did — in a chilling drama that ended with her im-

pregnation by the creatures, who returned before the due date to claim the fetus she was carrying.

Gagged! Astronauts' bizarre close encounters

AS American astronauts and Russian cosmonauts began to boldly go where none had gone before, incredible rumors that those pioneering space probes had encountered UFOs began to surface.
All were firmly denied by NASA, but the men who were there knew the truth. "At no time, when the astronauts were in space were they alone," says Mercury 7 astronaut Scott Carpenter. "There was a constant surveillance by UFOs."
Carpenter and the other brave explorers were forbidden to tell of their bizarre encounters with watchers from other worlds. And the true tales were locked away for 30 years in the X-Files.
But now, the astronauts have begun to speak openly for the first time. Colonel L. Gordon Cooper, veteran of both Gemini and Mercury

flights, has explained the strict code of silence NASA demanded of space crews as it dismissed dozens of UFO encounters as sightings of "space junk" or "reflections given off by Earth-launched satellites."
"For many years I have lived with a secret," Cooper reveals. "It was a secrecy imposed on all specialists and astronauts."
"I can now reveal that every day in the USA our radar instruments capture objects of a form and composition unknown to us. And there are thousands of witness reports and a quantity of documents to prove this, but nobody wants to make them public."
"Why? Because the authorities are afraid that people may think of some kind of horrible invaders. So the password still is: 'We have to avoid panic by all means.'"
Captain Edgar Mitchell, an Apollo astronaut who walked on the moon, says: "We all know that UFOs are real. All we need to ask is where they come from."

Cattle mutilations — the shocking truth



WESTERN ranching states were gripped in panic for nearly 10 years beginning in the early '70s as the nighttime sky shrieked with waves of unidentified flying objects.
With each new sunrise, the horror was magnified as frightened cattle ranchers found the ground littered with the grotesquely mutilated bodies of their prized herds.
Stunned experts would discover the cattle corpses were not victims of some random butchery or wild animal predators. They autopsied the creatures and found they'd been operated on by someone — or something — using what appeared to be advanced laser technology.
Many times, sexual organs, fetuses and eyes were removed, as well as every drop of blood the

animal had contained. Nearly 10,000 died.
Special state and federal task forces were formed to find out what really killed the animals. Reports were filed — then covered up.
New Mexico State Police Officer Gabriel Valdez wrote about one incident:
"Investigation showed that this 11-month-old bull had been dropped by some type of aircraft," Valdez wrote.
"The rectum and sex organs had been removed with a sharp and precise instrument. Prints were found north of the slain animal. The 4-inch footprints were round and led to what was apparently a hovering aircraft."
