There's game trails. I can't tell what's been through it. I haven't found any really succinct footprints, but there's bear and deer coming through here.

As long as humans can stay away from these creatures, I think we'll keep the peace.

No power, no cable, no phone lines. We ran our ranch off of a generator.

All of a sudden, out of the corner of my eye, I look up at the top of the ridge and there was something which we thought was an aircraft.

That was on fire.

It was something, literally traveling with us, the same direction we were traveling, but it was moving way faster.

The sightings from Kodiak that Debbie has documented include flying saucer-like craft of the kind seen by Jenny, as well as more distant, less-defined bodies of light.

Most of the sightings that I researched were either silver-metallic, saucer-shaped craft, or strange, unexplained balls of light that will hover for a while and then move rapidly out into the distance.

One of them, in particular, had one great big bright yellow light in front and two other white lights behind it and then just moved kind of up at an angle and then shot off really quick.

Investigative journalist Andrew Goff has been looking into one case from 1950 that sent shockwaves to the highest level.

Look at this. This is astonishing. It's an official report from the U.S. Navy from 1950.
