At least eight witnesses observed a large

hovering over the town.

Witnesses reported that, at

times, the object appeared

116

to hover as low as 200

feet from the ground.

The witness described

the object as metallic

118

silvery-gray in color, elliptical in shape

119

like two saucers fastened rim to rim.

After hovering for about seven seconds,

121

the object sped towards the
southwest at terrific speed.

January and February of
1973, in Cherokee County

South Carolina, the

police department received

124

so many UFO sighting
reports, that they stopped

sending cars out to investigate.

The sightings reported to
police were in the hundreds,

127

the objects described as
cylindrical, cigar-shaped,

triangular, and round like a
saucer with a cabin on top.

By the end of February,
sky-watching had become

so popular, that on one
night, more than 50 cars

131

were parked along the
roadside in hopes of catching

132

a glimpse of the object.

133

During February at Wood
River Junction, Rhode Island,

134

week after week, numerous

residents claimed

135

that they had seen a

huge, bright, white light

136

moving slowly above the community.

137

More than 250 people report

having seen the object

138

since it was first sighted.

The object was said to have

been larger than a car,

140

and almost half the size of a house,

141

00:08:30,290 --> 00:08:33,070

and hovered soundlessly over the treetops.

142

A number of the sightings occurred

143

00:08:34,450 --> 00:08:38,313

near the United Nuclear

Corporation Plant located nearby.

144

Then on March the 1st, 1973,

in Sailors Lake, Pennsylvania

145

there were 42 objects with flashing lights

146

00:08:48,820 --> 00:08:52,910

observed by multiple witnesses
during a three hour period.

The sightings occurred over
a small lakeside community

148

in eastern Pennsylvania,
near the New Jersey border.

A dozen witnesses,
including a state trooper,

150

observed the objects
passing over the lake.

Trooper Jeffrey Hunts, sent
to the town to investigate,

152

00:09:08,350 --> 00:09:11,100

said he observed four
objects pass over the lake

153

from west to east, that
looked like a Christmas tree

154

00:09:14,020 --> 00:09:15,680

flying in the air.

155

A major UFO wave hits a three county area

156

00:09:19,130 --> 00:09:23,120

of eastern Pennsylvania,
mostly round and oval-lighted

157

00:09:23,120 --> 00:09:26,425

objects were reported throughout March.

158

00:09:26,425 --> 00:09:29,290

(ominous music)

159

00:09:29,290 --> 00:09:33,460

By April 6th of 1973,

in Ellsinore, Missouri,

160

00:09:33,460 --> 00:09:37,000

at 11:30 a.m., a dome, disc-shaped object

161

00:09:37,000 --> 00:09:40,330

with portholes and landing

gear, lands in the woods

162

00:09:40,330 --> 00:09:42,910

four miles west of Ellsinore, Missouri.

163

00:09:42,910 --> 00:09:45,770

Three holes in the ground
arranged in a triangular pattern

164

00:09:45,770 --> 00:09:47,630

were found at the landing site,

165

00:09:47,630 --> 00:09:49,970

along with some damaged foliage.

166

00:09:49,970 --> 00:09:54,090

And on April 10th, 1973, in
Stoddard County, Missouri,

167

00:09:54,090 --> 00:09:57,320

sheriffs and others
reported at least three UFOs

168

00:09:57,320 --> 00:09:59,430

over Bernie and in Dexter.

169

00:09:59,430 --> 00:10:02,510

Objects changed color

from white to red to blue,

170

00:10:02,510 --> 00:10:05,970

moved irregularly across the

sky, starting and stopping,

171

00:10:05,970 --> 00:10:07,970

and changing their speed.

172

00:10:07,970 --> 00:10:12,620

On May the 12th, 1973, near

Kent, Ohio at 9:20 p.m.

173

00:10:12,620 --> 00:10:17,120

a witness was driving west

on Route 76, near Kent

174

00:10:17,120 --> 00:10:19,790

when he observed a group
of flashing lights overhead

175

00:10:19,790 --> 00:10:21,550

directly above the car.

176

00:10:21,550 --> 00:10:23,720

He stopped, and the lights stopped.

177

00:10:23,720 --> 00:10:26,820

He described a football-shaped
object that flashed

178

00:10:26,820 --> 00:10:30,710

from red to blue to white
in a repeating cycle,

179

00:10:30,710 --> 00:10:34,720

then he saw a figure materialize

approximately 10 feet

180

00:10:34,720 --> 00:10:36,100

below the object.

181

00:10:36,100 --> 00:10:39,240

The figure was human in
shape, clad all in silver,

182

00:10:39,240 --> 00:10:41,220

and rapidly descended to the highway

183

00:10:41,220 --> 00:10:43,320

directly in front of the car.

184

00:10:43,320 --> 00:10:46,410

The figure stood rigidly in a
position looking to the right,

185

00:10:46,410 --> 00:10:48,510

then turned its head to the left,

186

00:10:48,510 --> 00:10:50,170

and looked at the witness.

187

00:10:50,170 --> 00:10:54,620

After about 30 seconds, the
figure again ascended rapidly.

188

It was shaped exactly like a
human, but was entirely silver

189

00:10:58,350 --> 00:11:01,633

in color, lacking hair, eyes, and ears.

190

00:11:03,470 --> 00:11:07,920

By the summer of 1973,
UFO reports continued.

191

00:11:07,920 --> 00:11:10,910

On June the 2nd, in Divernon, Illinois,

192

00:11:10,910 --> 00:11:14,060

a UFO with a series of

bright running lights

193

00:11:14,060 --> 00:11:16,590

similar to aircraft lights, was seen.

194

00:11:16,590 --> 00:11:20,350

A large orange-red light was

turned on beneath the UFO

195

00:11:20,350 --> 00:11:23,120

which lit up the entire landscape.

196

00:11:23,120 --> 00:11:26,780

On July the 13th in Emden,

Missouri at 3:30 a.a,

197

00:11:26,780 --> 00:11:29,770

a witness arose when
the dog began barking.

198

00:11:29,770 --> 00:11:33,000

The UFO was described as
egg-shaped, or oblong,

199

00:11:33,000 --> 00:11:35,180

about the size of an average car.

200

00:11:35,180 --> 00:11:37,110

It had a three-dimensional appearance,

201

00:11:37,110 --> 00:11:40,150

like you could look through
it, or right into it.

202

00:11:40,150 --> 00:11:42,650

The outside was orange,

and toward the center

203

00:11:42,650 --> 00:11:45,890

it was brighter in a
slightly different color.

204

00:11:45,890 --> 00:11:47,980

Then, from August to October,

205

00:11:47,980 --> 00:11:50,870

there were a flurry of
sightings, in Alabama,

206

00:11:50,870 --> 00:11:53,970

Georgia, Louisiana, and Mississippi.

207

00:11:53,970 --> 00:11:58,020

Witnessed by local and state
police, and many others.

208

00:11:58,020 --> 00:12:01,130

Fast-moving oblong objects,
with bright, flashing

209

00:12:01,130 --> 00:12:02,603

or revolving lights.

210

00:12:07,610 --> 00:12:12,610

On September 19th of 1973,
this famous UFO case occurred.

211

00:12:13,240 --> 00:12:16,230

After midnight, above Tehran, Iran,

212

00:12:16,230 --> 00:12:19,420

two successive F4 interceptors attempted

213

00:12:19,420 --> 00:12:22,000

to catch a radar-visual UFO

214

00:12:22,000 --> 00:12:24,850

that had been widely
reported by civilians.

215

00:12:24,850 --> 00:12:28,260

Each time visual contact
was made, the crew attempted

216

00:12:28,260 --> 00:12:30,940

to arm a missile and prepare to fire it.

217

00:12:30,940 --> 00:12:33,790

However, the weapon
systems electronics failed

218

00:12:33,790 --> 00:12:35,133

on board the aircraft.

219

00:12:40,140 --> 00:12:44,960

Worldwide during 1973, UFOs
were also being reported.

220

00:12:44,960 --> 00:12:48,080

Spain experienced a major

flap, along with Brazil,

221

00:12:48,080 --> 00:12:49,900

Belgium, and Australia.

222

00:12:49,900 --> 00:12:52,230

And on September the 20th of '73,

223

00:12:52,230 --> 00:12:55,240

the 59th day of flight of Skylab III

224

00:12:55,240 --> 00:12:57,600

astronauts witnessed and photographed

225

00:12:57,600 --> 00:13:01,070

a strange, red object,

not more than 30 to 50

226

00:13:01,070 --> 00:13:03,140

nautical miles from them, Alan Bean,

227

00:13:03,140 --> 00:13:06,230

Owen Garret, and Jack

Lousma, reported the object

228

00:13:06,230 --> 00:13:08,643

was brighter than any of the planets.

229

00:13:17,400 --> 00:13:20,370

October of 1973 would become known

230

00:13:20,370 --> 00:13:22,570

as the month of the humanoids.

231

00:13:22,570 --> 00:13:25,270

Two famous cases emerged from this month.

232

00:13:25,270 --> 00:13:28,080

The Charles Hickson and

Calvin Parker abduction

233

00:13:28,080 --> 00:13:30,300

and the Jeff Greenhaw encounter.

234

00:13:30,300 --> 00:13:33,233

Both cases remain unexplained to this day.

235

00:13:43,490 --> 00:13:45,660

On a cool autumn evening in the south,

236

00:13:45,660 --> 00:13:47,000

many residents were thinking

237

00:13:47,000 --> 00:13:50,520

of the upcoming Mac Davis

concert, or football games.

238

00:13:50,520 --> 00:13:53,270

No one expected a UFO invasion.

239

00:13:53,270 --> 00:13:57,310

That would change on October 10th, 1973,

240

00:13:57,310 --> 00:13:59,850

15 different people,

including two policemen,

241

00:13:59,850 --> 00:14:02,940

reported seeing a large, silver UFO

242

00:14:02,940 --> 00:14:05,130

slowly fly over a housing project

243

00:14:05,130 --> 00:14:07,630

in St. Tammany Parish, New Orleans.

244

00:14:07,630 --> 00:14:09,630

The next day would be a day to remember

245

00:14:09,630 --> 00:14:13,010

for two fishermen in

Pascagoula, Mississippi.

246

00:14:13,010 --> 00:14:16,640

It was the night of October 11th, 1973.

247

00:14:16,640 --> 00:14:18,060

Charles Hickson went fishing

248

00:14:18,060 --> 00:14:20,870

with 18 year old Calvin Parker from a pier

249

00:14:20,870 --> 00:14:22,830

at Shaupeter shipyard.

250

00:14:22,830 --> 00:14:24,780

The spot was an abandoned shipyard

251

00:14:24,780 --> 00:14:26,740

along the Pascagoula River,

252

00:14:26,740 --> 00:14:29,430

at the southeastern tip of Mississippi.

253

00:14:29,430 --> 00:14:32,500

The two men intended to test

some new fishing equipment,

254

00:14:32,500 --> 00:14:34,740

but had little success,

and were about to look

255

00:14:34,740 --> 00:14:36,430

for a better place.

256

00:14:36,430 --> 00:14:38,790

At 7:00 p.m. on this dark night,

257

00:14:38,790 --> 00:14:40,090

they directed their attention

258

00:14:40,090 --> 00:14:43,290

to a loud, zipping sound,

coming from behind them.

259

00:14:43,290 --> 00:14:45,740

They turned around to see

the source of the sound,

260

00:14:45,740 --> 00:14:48,140

and were amazed and also terrified,

261

00:14:48,140 --> 00:14:51,980

to see a gray domed football-shaped

or egg-shaped object

262

00:14:51,980 --> 00:14:55,130

surrounded by a blue glow,
hovering towards them.

263

00:14:55,130 --> 00:14:57,633

- And as I turned around
from the pier and looked,

264

00:14:58,610 --> 00:15:00,940

something had come almost to the ground

265

00:15:00,940 --> 00:15:04,810

it was hovering probably two
foot, 18 inches or two foot

266

00:15:04,810 --> 00:15:09,100

from the ground, and I
assumed Calvin had heard

267

00:15:09,100 --> 00:15:10,500

the noise at that time.

268

00:15:10,500 --> 00:15:12,411

He turned and looked.

269

00:15:12,411 --> 00:15:14,120

And there was some kind of door,

270

00:15:14,120 --> 00:15:16,370

or sliding door, I suppose,

271

00:15:16,370 --> 00:15:19,203

came into the end of the

crack that was toward us,

272

00:15:20,050 --> 00:15:22,250

a very brilliant light

came out of the crack

273

00:15:23,190 --> 00:15:24,533

and I didn't know what to do.

274

00:15:24,533 --> 00:15:25,450

It startled me at first.

275

00:15:25,450 --> 00:15:28,780

I couldn't make out what it was.

276

00:15:28,780 --> 00:15:32,650

And about that time it was three things

277

00:15:32,650 --> 00:15:34,410

begin to move into the doorway.

278

00:15:34,410 --> 00:15:36,500

They came out the beam of light, came out

279

00:15:36,500 --> 00:15:40,960

to Calvin and myself, and one

took hold of this shoulder

280

and one of this shoulder,

and I seemed to rise up

281

on the ground, about the

height that they were,

282

and we started to go into the crack.

This time, I saw Calvin.

This UFO sighting occurred in
the fall of the year of 1973.

This was probably old news by that time.

But it was a week or so

later that I began to hear

the rumblings of what had

happened in Pascagoula.

And I was very, very

curious because I remembered

what I had seen, and how it had scared me.

I know it was the fall of the year

1619

because it was beginning

to turn cooler at night

and football season was around.

1621

But ever since then, I have

wondered what UFOs are.

1622

What are these things?

1623

In 1975, a friend and

I, a friend that lived

1624

up the road from me, we

both watched a silver ball

1625

in the sky for about ten minutes.

And it stayed stationary

while clouds moved above it

1627

and then eventually below

it, and covered it up.

And we had no idea what that was.

1629

And since then I have

seen a few other things.

1630

Including a red light over the horizon

1631

at Gulf Breeze in Florida.

1632

01:15:22,630 --> 01:15:23,593

And ...

1633

01:15:26,280 --> 01:15:31,080

A saucer shaped thing

riding down Highway 49

1634

01:15:31,080 --> 01:15:32,253

going to the coast.

1635

01:15:33,520 --> 01:15:36,200

I was looking through,

driving, so I'm looking

1636

01:15:36,200 --> 01:15:37,980

through the front windshield of the car.

1637

01:15:37,980 --> 01:15:40,280

And it dropped like this

1638

01:15:40,280 --> 01:15:42,963

kind of kicked back and then took off.

1639

01:15:46,147 --> 01:15:48,803

A mile or so ahead of me,

wondered what that was.

1640

01:15:51,250 --> 01:15:54,340

So I've had several UFO

sightings in my life.

1641

I don't know why I see

them more than anyone else.

I know that I do.

Maybe other people see

them as often as I do

sort of kept it in the back of my mind

1649

that one day you're gonna produce

1650

01:16:20,730 --> 01:16:23,203

a really neat documentary on UFOs.

1651

So that was my inspiration for wanting

1652

01:16:28,670 --> 01:16:30,543

to produce this documentary.

1653

1973 was so active

1654

01:16:35,470 --> 01:16:38,213

as far as UFO activity.

1655

Even though I remember my experience

1656

01:16:43,750 --> 01:16:47,520

seeing the big orange ball

and whatever the heck it was

1657

01:16:48,950 --> 01:16:52,130

and hearing about the Pascagoula incident,

1658

01:16:52,130 --> 01:16:57,130

most of the UFO activity

that occurred in 1973

1659

01:16:57,370 --> 01:17:00,660

I was completely oblivious to

it because being 12 years old

1660

01:17:00,660 --> 01:17:02,460

you just didn't watch the news.

1661

01:17:02,460 --> 01:17:07,130

I didn't keep up with
television for that reason

1662

01:17:07,130 --> 01:17:08,780

I wanted to watch adventure shows,

1663

01:17:08,780 --> 01:17:12,830

or something like that,
so I never saw the news.

1664

01:17:12,830 --> 01:17:14,570

And it wouldn't be until later

1665

01:17:15,860 --> 01:17:20,860

when I would read books,
magazines, and watch movies

1666

01:17:21,400 --> 01:17:24,820

at the theater and then on
television about that year

1667

01:17:24,820 --> 01:17:26,600

and about things that happened

1668

01:17:26,600 --> 01:17:31,503

that I really came to realize

just how active 1973 was.

1669

There were a lot of events

that occurred in 1973.

1670

So when I began thinking

about, I'm gonna produce

1671

a documentary on UFOs, I

to that time period.

That point where I remember
seeing the first thing

1674

that I couldn't explain.

1675

The first UFO.

1676

And ...

I have no idea to this day what it was.

I know that it probably

is not anything that

1679

any country on this planet

is capable of producing.

1680

Certainly not at that time.

1681

And perhaps not even now.

1682

This thing was totally silent

1683

01:18:17,970 --> 01:18:22,970

very, very bright, and just

floated through the air.

1684

I don't know of any aircraft that we have

1685

01:18:27,310 --> 01:18:31,610

or balloon that we have

that could function that way

1686

01:18:31,610 --> 01:18:33,130

without you being able to look at it

1687

01:18:33,130 --> 01:18:35,240

at that distance, you

know the average tree

1688

01:18:35,240 --> 01:18:38,990

in Mississippi is 75, 80, 90 feet high.

1689

01:18:38,990 --> 01:18:41,256

And this was just above the treetops.

1690

01:18:41,256 --> 01:18:42,190

And it was bigger than a car.

1691

01:18:42,190 --> 01:18:44,184

If it were a balloon, I think I could tell

1692

01:18:44,184 --> 01:18:45,880

if it was a balloon

1693

01:18:45,880 --> 01:18:48,800

so I don't know what it was, you know.

1694

01:18:48,800 --> 01:18:51,386

And the subsequent things

that I've seen since then

1695

I don't know what they are.

1696

I call them unidentified flying objects

1697

and they were flying.
