He ran a couple of tests on it, and it couldn't be cut by torch,

409

it couldn't be burnt, it couldn't be cut by hacksaw or clippers or anything.

410

But you could take it in your hands, crumble it up like tin foil,

411

and open your hand up, and it would pop out to its original shape.

Chuck, that's exactly how Sandy Proctor described it.

but when the government came in, they said it was a weather balloon,

416

417

In 1947, the U.S. Army Air Forces launched a top-secret project called Operation Mogul,

418

which involved microphones flown on high-altitude balloons

419

00:24:20,000 --> 00:24:28,000

used to detect sound waves generated by Soviet atomic bomb tests.

420

00:24:28,000 --> 00:24:34,000

In 1994, after public pressure to resolve the controversy behind the Roswell incident,

421

00:24:34,000 --> 00:24:40,000

the government released declassified documents and claimed the remnants of the crash

422

00:24:40,000 --> 00:24:42,000

belonged to one of these balloons.

423

00:24:42,000 --> 00:24:48,000

According to family legend, he took these pieces of metal

424

00:24:48,000 --> 00:24:55,000

and hid it away in what the family considers Dan's cave.

425

00:24:55,000 --> 00:25:01,000

Are you telling me that this location could house ailing debris?

426

00:25:01,000 --> 00:25:03,000

It possibly could, yes.

427

00:25:03,000 --> 00:25:05,000

And you know where this cave is?

428

00:25:05,000 --> 00:25:15,000

I've got my suspicions of where several entrances are, but I don't have definite proof of where they are.

429

Have you ever tried to go check it out for yourself?
