We're just going to check this with the metal detector and with a geyer counter.

We're looking for anything, the metal terry.

267

The last thing we're going to do is to see if there's a body or something buried there.

268

Sounds like a plan.

269

Okay, straight over the mound this way.

270

When I was in law enforcement, we used grid searching to look for evidence.

271

If you want to work towards the mound and look for any type of evidence that might be surrounding it.

Go ahead and grab your metal detector.

While Heather's using the metal detector, I want you to do a recon.

Okay?

I'm just looking for maybe an old K ration or something from the military.

Anything that looks like someone who has been out here.

The three of us are using three different methods to search the area.

284

Heather's using a metal detector to look for scrap metal that might have been left behind.

285

My dad's looking for traces of radiation.

286

And I'm on a perimeter search.

287
