Where we're headed right now is West Cliff, Colorado.

48

We're gonna be talking to a rancher there about a strange animal death.

49

He thinks it's connected to UFOs.

50

And it's a really interesting yet very scary case,

51

because whatever killed his horse, killed his cow, killed his hog,

52

00:02:32,000 --> 00:02:36,000

and then killed these other animals, and we don't know why they're dying.

53

So you go to a rancher, and he's having all these mysterious cattle deaths,

54

and he has no idea why they're happening.

55

Does he notice that he starts experiencing unusual activity

56

right before this happens, or during, or...?

57

They've seen balls of light either a month or two before,

58

or even a couple days prior to the strange animal death.

Not every case, but the majority of cases, shows tie-in between UFOs and strange animal deaths.

60

Which has been the case since 1967. It's nothing new.

61

In the late 1960s, the United States started experiencing strange animal deaths

62

at an alarming rate. The incidents occurred from Oklahoma to Nebraska.

63

Animals were being slaughtered, some with bizarre incisions,

64

and many under circumstances that defy explanation.

In a span of only two years, 130 cases were reported in Colorado alone.

Newly declassified files from 1978

67

allegedly reveal that federal authorities investigated a strange animal death in Taos, New Mexico.

68

The FBI probe appears to have recovered an unidentifiable substance from the scene of mutilated animals.

In that same month. In that same town.

70

00:03:58,000 --> 00:04:03,000

Another FBI report purportedly cites evidence of a similar material.

71

This time at the site of an alleged UFO encounter.

From here, the paper trail appears to go cold.

73

I've been investigating strange animal deaths for over 28 years now.

This case is very important to me, because it's very similar to the one that cost me my badge.

The case where I lost my badge, they had no other choice.

77

They can't leave it as open case, so they closed it.

78

And then when I contradicted them, basically saying, you know, this is a paranormal case,

79

someone in my department pulled my badge.

80

Did you try to like fight it or anything?

81

What happened?

82

Were you just like, I'm done?

83

Oh yeah, you know, for the longest time.

84

If you typed deputy fired UFO on the internet, my name popped up.

85

They went international.

86

Wow.

Mr. Walker, nice to see you.

88

Nice to meet you.

Nice to meet you.

90

This is Heather, and she's going to help me investigate what's going on.

91

How many animals have you lost?

92

Well, I lost the two goats, the three steer, the hog, and the mare within a week and a half died.

93

And it's been unreal trying to get information what caused it.

I fed the steer the night before, and he was up around Balkan, acting normal,

95

ate half his feed while I was standing there beside him,

96

and next morning he's laying there dead.

What'd you kill him?

98

I don't know.

99

You know, I've had water checks, the grain that I was feeding him,

100

I kept feeding my stallion, and he's, well, there he is right away.

101

He's the only one that survived.

102

And there's no signs that all of a predator killing it.

103

No sign of struggle?

104

Nothing.

105

00:06:06,000 --> 00:06:08,000

I mean, very strange.

106

The mare, when I come out and found her, she was dead.

107

She was somewhere between seven and eight months pregnant,

108

00:06:17,000 --> 00:06:21,000

and she was to the point you could feel the cold kick,

109

00:06:21,000 --> 00:06:27,000

and whenever the necropsy found out she wasn't pregnant.

And there was no sign of a cold.

111

No sign that she aborted were to cope with it.

112

I mean, you would definitely see signs of fetus laying around somewhere.

As far as a vet's concerned, it was never pregnant.

They won't talk to me.

The state vet won't talk to me.

117

That must be frustrating.

118

It is.

119

They're not doing his job.

120

00:06:55,000 --> 00:06:57,000

You're talking about a red flag.

121

That was a real big one.

122

Yeah.

123

They also heard reports of strange lights seen in the area.

124

See strange lights all the time over these mountains.

125

I had a light right back at my back fence.

126

One of them pitch black nights in the moon, and it was a very bright light.

127

It's on maybe 200 yards.

128

I picked up a rifle with a scope to see what it was.

129

All of a sudden, that one happened.

130

Do you think there might be a correlation between those lights and your animals dying?

131

You tell me.

132

You sit there and watch your mountains for a week at night,

133

00:07:35,000 --> 00:07:38,000

and you're gonna see some strange stuff.

134

So this is the location that the mayor was found?

135

00:07:42,000 --> 00:07:43,000

Yep.

136

00:07:43,000 --> 00:07:45,000

When we come back out tonight,

137

00:07:45,000 --> 00:07:48,000

the first thing we're gonna do is we're gonna scrape some snow in different areas here.

138

Then we're gonna use our ultraviolet lights,

139

00:07:51,000 --> 00:07:55,000

and we're gonna look for any blood that might be still present in the area.

140

00:07:55,000 --> 00:07:59,000

Then we're gonna hit it with a Geiger counter to make sure that there's no radiation here.

141

We wanna make sure it's safe for your other animals and for you.

142

And we're gonna see if there's any type of electromagnetic fields in this area.

143

So does that sound like a good idea?

144

Yep.

145

And I'm fine with it.

146

While we're waiting for the sun to go down,

149

See if I can learn anything from him or what's going on in this area.

Then we'll reconvene and compare it to us, okay?

While Chuck and Heather are following up on their investigation,

157

Dan is looking into additional leads.

158

Hey, Mike, this is Dan Zuchowski.

159

00:08:38,000 --> 00:08:43,000

So my dad was talking to me a little bit about how you had some strange animal deaths in the past.

160

00:08:43,000 --> 00:08:46,000

I was wondering if you could kind of tell me about that a little bit.

161

00:08:46,000 --> 00:08:49,000

I've had two cows that were mutilated.

162

00:08:49,000 --> 00:08:51,000

There were no tracks at all.

163

00:08:51,000 --> 00:08:52,000

Wow.

164

00:08:52,000 --> 00:08:55,000

You know, it was kind of crazy.

165

00:08:55,000 --> 00:08:58,000

At first I thought she had died just of old age.

166

00:08:58,000 --> 00:09:02,000

And then when I went over, I saw that she had been mutilated also.

167

00:09:02,000 --> 00:09:05,000

Can you text me your address and I'll get my team and we'll head out there?

168

00:09:05,000 --> 00:09:06,000

Okay.

169

00:09:06,000 --> 00:09:08,000

Awesome. Thanks, Mike. We'll talk to you here in a little bit.

170

00:09:08,000 --> 00:09:09,000

Okay, thanks, man.

171

00:09:09,000 --> 00:09:10,000

All right, thanks.

172

00:09:10,000 --> 00:09:15,000

Deputy Kando was the first person on scene when Rancher Walker lost his horse.

173

00:09:15,000 --> 00:09:17,000

I'm here to learn what he knows.

174

00:09:17,000 --> 00:09:20,000

It was my case originally.

175

00:09:20,000 --> 00:09:24,000

Tommy said that he went to bed, got up that morning at 7 o'clock.

176

00:09:24,000 --> 00:09:28,000

8.30, you notice that the horse was dead.

177

00:09:28,000 --> 00:09:30,000

And I just snowed that morning.

178

00:09:30,000 --> 00:09:31,000

I was in the car.

179

00:09:31,000 --> 00:09:32,000

I was in the car.

180

00:09:32,000 --> 00:09:33,000

I was in the car.

181

00:09:33,000 --> 00:09:34,000

Dead.

182

00:09:34,000 --> 00:09:36,000

Just snowed that morning.

183

00:09:36,000 --> 00:09:39,000

I don't remember a lot of footsteps.

184

00:09:39,000 --> 00:09:44,000

And initially I observed that the sexual organs had been removed from the horse.

185

00:09:44,000 --> 00:09:47,000

Is this the first time you've ever seen anything like this?

186

00:09:47,000 --> 00:09:49,000

It's the first time I've ever seen anything like this on a horse.

187

00:09:49,000 --> 00:09:54,000

So you've had strange animal deaths out here before then reported to the office?

188

00:09:54,000 --> 00:09:56,000

Yeah, mostly cattle though.

189

00:09:56,000 --> 00:10:00,000

And they have the same type of cuts or marks?

190

00:10:00,000 --> 00:10:04,000

In general, yeah, it usually is soft tissue.

191

00:10:04,000 --> 00:10:10,000

Since 67, we've had an estimate close to 10,000 cases across the United States.

192

00:10:10,000 --> 00:10:21,000

And out of all the cases that were investigated, no law enforcement agency has been able to pin anything directly related to either a predator or to a human.

193

00:10:21,000 --> 00:10:22,000

Honestly, they're pretty hard.

194

00:10:22,000 --> 00:10:25,000

They're really hard to tell how the animal dies.

195

00:10:25,000 --> 00:10:32,000

Usually there's not a lot of blood anywhere around the scene and the wounds.

196

00:10:32,000 --> 00:10:39,000

They're almost always a dead end because unless you see it happen, you know, you can only speculate what it might be.

197

00:10:39,000 --> 00:10:46,000

So if you would have saw some type of human evidence, then you probably would have marked the case report animal cruelty?

198

00:10:46,000 --> 00:10:49,000

Yeah, yeah, you would go down that animal cruelty route, yeah.

199

00:10:49,000 --> 00:10:51,000

Okay, but this one is not?

200

00:10:51,000 --> 00:10:58,000

I didn't classify it as animal cruelty because I have nothing to say that it was really animal cruelty.

201

00:10:58,000 --> 00:11:04,000

You can never really tell what does it, who does it, whatever you want to go with.

202

00:11:04,000 --> 00:11:10,000

When I interviewed Rancher Walker, he told me that his horse was pregnant.

203

00:11:10,000 --> 00:11:16,000

The initial report he got back from the vet was there was no fetus in the horse.

204

00:11:16,000 --> 00:11:23,000

And he swears that the horse was pregnant because he could feel that there was something inside.

205

00:11:23,000 --> 00:11:26,000

I have no idea how you would explain that.

206

00:11:26,000 --> 00:11:32,000

Honestly, because when I was there, I mean, it looked pregnant.

207

00:11:32,000 --> 00:11:35,000

There's something strange happening.

208

00:11:35,000 --> 00:11:37,000

I don't know if human could do that.

209

00:11:37,000 --> 00:11:38,000

It was an earthquake.

210

00:11:38,000 --> 00:11:40,000

It's too bright for a satellite.

211

00:11:47,000 --> 00:12:00,000

After questioning a local deputy about the strange animal deaths in the area, Chuck regroupes with Heather to hear about her progress.

212

00:12:00,000 --> 00:12:02,000

What did you find out?

213

00:12:02,000 --> 00:12:06,000

Well, I can really understand Tom's struggle because those calls were pointless.

214

00:12:06,000 --> 00:12:08,000

I didn't get anywhere.

215

00:12:08,000 --> 00:12:12,000

I called the local vet and they told me they couldn't tell me any information.

216

00:12:12,000 --> 00:12:17,000

So I called the state vet through the Department of Agriculture and they just kept saying,

217

00:12:17,000 --> 00:12:19,000

we can't disclose any of this information to you.

218

00:12:19,000 --> 00:12:20,000

So you got stonewalled?

219

00:12:20,000 --> 00:12:23,000

Yeah, and then I even called the game ward and nothing.

220

00:12:23,000 --> 00:12:24,000

No one will talk to you?

221

00:12:24,000 --> 00:12:27,000

No. No one will say anything.

222

00:12:27,000 --> 00:12:29,000

Did you find out anything from the sheriff?

223

00:12:29,000 --> 00:12:32,000

They don't know what happened to the animal.

224

00:12:32,000 --> 00:12:33,000

They don't know how it died.

225

00:12:33,000 --> 00:12:35,000

They have no evidence.

226

00:12:35,000 --> 00:12:37,000

It was a human.

227

00:12:37,000 --> 00:12:41,000

It really looks like there's something going on here and people aren't talking about it.

228

00:12:41,000 --> 00:12:48,000

So, you know, we really need to get out there tonight, see if we can find our own answers and figure out what's going on.

229

00:12:54,000 --> 00:13:00,000

While Dan continues to pursue other leads, Chuck and Heather return to Tom Walker's ranch,

230

00:13:00,000 --> 00:13:07,000

searching for any evidence that can lead them closer to the truth about the strange animal deaths.

231

00:13:08,000 --> 00:13:17,000

The question remains, was it a human, predator, or some other worldly being that harmed these animals?

232

00:13:17,000 --> 00:13:20,000

This is the exact spot where Rancher Walker's mare died.

233

00:13:20,000 --> 00:13:25,000

So, first thing I want to do is I want to test the soil for any type of radiation.

234

00:13:25,000 --> 00:13:32,000

I'm looking for any type of residual substances that might have been left behind, like the cases from the late 70s.

235

00:13:32,000 --> 00:13:35,000

I'm inside that pack. You're going to find a geiger counter.

236

00:13:35,000 --> 00:13:36,000

Here.

237

00:13:40,000 --> 00:13:46,000

Picking up just a little bit of the ambient here, but not enough to worry about.

238

00:13:46,000 --> 00:13:51,000

Since we're right here in Mazelchikiameth, you have the pack.

239

00:13:51,000 --> 00:13:53,000

There we go.

240

00:13:54,000 --> 00:13:59,000

Neil right now is majoring in micro-teslas, so that's like three micro-teslas.

241

00:13:59,000 --> 00:14:04,000

That's about ambient, so everything reading-wise at this point is normal.

242

00:14:04,000 --> 00:14:09,000

So next what we need to do is grab the light I have.

243

00:14:09,000 --> 00:14:10,000

It's in here?

244

00:14:10,000 --> 00:14:11,000

Yeah.

245

00:14:11,000 --> 00:14:12,000

Okay.

246

00:14:12,000 --> 00:14:13,000

See right here.

247

00:14:14,000 --> 00:14:16,000

This is a blood light.

248

00:14:16,000 --> 00:14:21,000

If a predator killed his horse at this location, we'll see a lot of blood in the soil.

249

00:14:23,000 --> 00:14:25,000

It should turn up dark.

250

00:14:29,000 --> 00:14:31,000

I don't see any blood.

251

00:14:31,000 --> 00:14:34,000

There's around nine gallons of blood in the horse.

252

00:14:34,000 --> 00:14:36,000

There should have been blood at this site.

253

00:14:36,000 --> 00:14:39,000

So this wasn't a natural predator.

254

00:14:41,000 --> 00:14:43,000

What was that?

255

00:14:48,000 --> 00:14:49,000

That sounded like footsteps.

256

00:14:49,000 --> 00:14:51,000

I can't tell.

257

00:14:51,000 --> 00:14:53,000

Flashlight over there.

258

00:14:55,000 --> 00:14:57,000

I don't want anybody coming up on us.

259

00:15:00,000 --> 00:15:04,000

It could be the wind, but I mean, I didn't hear it before with the wind picking up.

260

00:15:04,000 --> 00:15:06,000

There's nobody over there.

261

00:15:07,000 --> 00:15:11,000

Just keep an eye out every now and then just kind of like flashlight over there.

262

00:15:11,000 --> 00:15:13,000

Because I don't want anybody walking up on us.

263

00:15:18,000 --> 00:15:24,000

The animal deaths on this ranch were accompanied by reports of strange lights overhead.

264

00:15:24,000 --> 00:15:31,000

The team surveys the night sky, searching for evidence of a connection between the two phenomena.

265

00:15:31,000 --> 00:15:33,000

Did you see the mountain range over here?

266

00:15:33,000 --> 00:15:34,000

Uh-huh.

267

00:15:34,000 --> 00:15:37,000

Okay, this is actually the continental divide that we're looking at.

268

00:15:37,000 --> 00:15:39,000

We're completely surrounded by mountains.

269

00:15:39,000 --> 00:15:43,000

The closest metropolitan city is 100 miles away behind me.

270

00:15:43,000 --> 00:15:45,000

There should be no lights out here.

271

00:15:45,000 --> 00:15:49,000

So we start standing at the top part using our cameras.

272

00:15:49,000 --> 00:15:52,000

We can start looking for any of those strange lights.

273

00:15:55,000 --> 00:15:57,000

I see something over here, Chuck.

274

00:16:01,000 --> 00:16:03,000

I counted 21 rib cages.

You're saying there was more afterwards.

It almost appears as someone takes the animal from location A to location B, and they do whatever they need to do to it, and then they bring it to location C, and they just place it there.

407

Also what was weird on this cow is that she had horns, okay?

This is a place that's got a lot of UFO history, not just really recently, but it goes way back.

Right.

And the river's just behind us, right?

We just passed the Purgatory River.

Hi, how you doing, Tom?

511

Hello.

512

I was over at Durant's place and we were talking about the balls of light they'd seen in the sky.

513

And then you had an animal death over here on your ranch too.

514

Yes.

You know, there was no blood, but its back was broke.

Something broke its back.

Tom, you've been ranching for a long time.

520

Do cows break their backs just falling over?

521

No, no.

522

00:29:41,000 --> 00:29:43,000

What does it take to break their back?

523

00:29:43,000 --> 00:29:47,000

It would take a real high fall.

524

00:29:47,000 --> 00:29:50,000

It would take a lot of force to break that back.

525

The first thing I look at is, you know, is there anything around here?

526

A cliff, you know, anything like that where the animals fell.
