The Pentagon released a video of the sighting

so we could actually see what was reported.

Steve Marillo is a retired military officer

73

who spent seven years of active duty as a jet pilot

and has since taken a keen interest in UFOs.

So this is commonly referred to as the Tic Tac video.

It was released in December of 2017

77

along with an article in The New York Times

and the Washington Post about the fact that the government has been studying UFOs.

So what you're looking at, guys, is a forward-looking infrared radar image

80

of this object from the F-18.

So right now, the state of the aircraft is straight and level.

It was a left-hand turn.

They head back to the cap and they get a call saying,

163

There is. Right there is Point Magoo, and there's an air base there.

F-18s fly out of there. So, yeah, that's where we're going to be.

165

Based on Steve's testimony and his theory about UFOs predictive analytics,

166

the team ventures north along Pacific Coast Highway in order to conduct a sky watch

167

00:08:59,000 --> 00:09:02,000

near the Naval Air Station at Point Magoo.

168

00:09:02,000 --> 00:09:06,000

Their objective, to determine whether there is a connection between the military

169

00:09:06,000 --> 00:09:09,000

and UFO activity along the coastline.

170

00:09:09,000 --> 00:09:13,000

So, Dad, Point Magoo, where we're going, is right across the street from a base

171

00:09:13,000 --> 00:09:17,000

that conducts aerial training and aerial exercises.

172

00:09:17,000 --> 00:09:22,000

So, I think based off of that, Point Magoo is going to be a good spot for us to set up our night watch.

173

00:09:22,000 --> 00:09:25,000

I hope that we'll be able to see some activity at the base,

174

00:09:25,000 --> 00:09:29,000

which may provoke some activity from UFOs in the area.

175

00:09:29,000 --> 00:09:33,000

Also, we have to keep in mind, things that we do right outside of a military base

176

00:09:33,000 --> 00:09:36,000

are going to be monitored. So, whatever we do out here,

177

00:09:36,000 --> 00:09:39,000

let's make sure we do it correct.

178

That's Point Magoo Rock out there, Dad.

179

00:09:44,000 --> 00:09:47,000

Located at the southern tip of Ventura County,

180

00:09:47,000 --> 00:09:52,000

the Naval Air Station at Point Magoo is a sprawling military complex

181

00:09:52,000 --> 00:09:57,000

comprised of aircraft runways, radar installations, tracking systems,

182

00:09:57,000 --> 00:10:02,000

and the only deep water port between Los Angeles and San Francisco.

183

00:10:07,000 --> 00:10:10,000

I'm not quite sure if we should actually stop here.

184

00:10:10,000 --> 00:10:14,000

We can't be anywhere near the base to do our sky watch tonight

185

00:10:14,000 --> 00:10:16,000

because of national defense issues.

186

00:10:16,000 --> 00:10:22,000

But what we can do is we can go up here tonight, overlook this whole area,

187

00:10:22,000 --> 00:10:24,000

and be away from the military base,

188

00:10:24,000 --> 00:10:27,000

but still be able to view the military base from our location.

189

Hello, Conver.

190

00:10:29,000 --> 00:10:31,000

We should probably go.

191

00:10:31,000 --> 00:10:32,000

What's that light?

192

That's right above the water light.

193

Hey, Heather, can you get eyes on this right light in the sky right there?

194

I see it.

195

Wow. Holy s***.

196

It's actually heading towards the base.

197

While investigating a possible connection between UFOs and the military

198

near the Naval Air Station at Point Magoo,

199

00:11:06,000 --> 00:11:07,000

Helicopter.

200

Chuck and the team encounter some unexpected company.

201

We should probably go.

202

00:11:13,000 --> 00:11:14,000

Yeah, let's get out of here.

203

Yeah, I think we better get out of here.

204

The fact that we just saw two helicopters tells me

205

00:11:23,000 --> 00:11:25,000

we're in the right place to monitor the military.

206

But we can't do it right under the noses.

207

We've got to get up in the hills there.

208

The team has secured a location along the coastline

209

00:11:37,000 --> 00:11:40,000

that will position them high above Point Magoo

210

00:11:40,000 --> 00:11:42,000

and provide optimal viewing of both the base

211

00:11:42,000 --> 00:11:45,000

and UFO activity over the water.

212

00:11:45,000 --> 00:11:48,000

This is definitely a good night for a sky watch.

213

The clouds are pulling off.

214

00:11:50,000 --> 00:11:53,000

We'll be able to see anything that flies through this area.

215

Dan, bring the telescope right over here.

216

00:11:56,000 --> 00:11:59,000

When you do sky watching for UFOs,

217

00:11:59,000 --> 00:12:00,000

you need the proper equipment.

218

Tonight, we came out with a high-powered telescope

219

00:12:02,000 --> 00:12:04,000

modified with a video camera.

220

00:12:04,000 --> 00:12:06,000

How's this angle, Chuck?

221

00:12:06,000 --> 00:12:10,000

We want to look 20 degrees off of the horizon along the area

222

00:12:10,000 --> 00:12:12,000

from Point Magoo out.

223

00:12:12,000 --> 00:12:14,000

We want to make sure we keep an eye on the water

224

00:12:14,000 --> 00:12:17,000

to see if we see any lights on the water at all.

225

00:12:17,000 --> 00:12:19,000

If we see any lights on the water,

226

00:12:19,000 --> 00:12:21,000

first we want to verify that it's not a boat.

227

00:12:21,000 --> 00:12:23,000

There could be some fishing boats out there.

228

I do see a red blinking light way out there.

229

00:12:29,000 --> 00:12:30,000

Sweet, tell us go down that way.

230

00:12:30,000 --> 00:12:31,000

Yep, I see it right now.

231

Is that a boat?

232

00:12:32,000 --> 00:12:33,000

I don't know.

233

00:12:33,000 --> 00:12:35,000

Oh, yeah.

234

00:12:35,000 --> 00:12:36,000

Okay.

235

00:12:36,000 --> 00:12:39,000

The nearby ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach

236

00:12:39,000 --> 00:12:41,000

are filled with marine traffic.

237

00:12:41,000 --> 00:12:44,000

The team needs to discern lights from maritime vessels

238

00:12:44,000 --> 00:12:48,000

as they search the horizon for anything unexplained.

239

00:12:48,000 --> 00:12:50,000

Okay, I'm going to keep scanning the sky.

240

00:12:54,000 --> 00:12:56,000

That's interesting.

241

00:12:56,000 --> 00:12:59,000

Hey, Dan, Heather, can I see a light blinking up there?

242

00:12:59,000 --> 00:13:02,000

I see a red and white strip on it.

243

00:13:02,000 --> 00:13:03,000

Do you?

244

00:13:03,000 --> 00:13:04,000

Yeah.

245

00:13:04,000 --> 00:13:05,000

Red and white.

246

00:13:05,000 --> 00:13:06,000

I can see it through here.

247

00:13:06,000 --> 00:13:07,000

It's definitely military.

248

00:13:07,000 --> 00:13:08,000

Yep.

249

00:13:08,000 --> 00:13:11,000

I saw it come off of the peak there where the Naval Air Station is.

250

00:13:11,000 --> 00:13:14,000

Do all the military helicopters have red lights on them?

251

00:13:14,000 --> 00:13:15,000

Is that like a new thing?

252

00:13:15,000 --> 00:13:19,000

Military aircraft have different lighting patterns.

253

Okay.

254

00:13:20,000 --> 00:13:23,000

So they can go completely black if they need to

255

00:13:23,000 --> 00:13:25,000

in like a tactical situation.

256

00:13:25,000 --> 00:13:26,000

Okay.

257

Let's go ahead and scan the telescope left to the right

258

00:13:28,000 --> 00:13:30,000

so we have any type of UFO interaction with it.

259

What's that light?

Look down here above the water.

261

Did it just show up?

Hey, Heather, can you get eyes on this right light in the sky right there?

What's your action?

Right in front of me.

267

00:13:48,000 --> 00:13:50,000

Right above the water line?

268

00:13:50,000 --> 00:13:51,000

Okay.

Let me know if I'm in your way.

270

Okay, zooming in.

271

I see it through here.

272

Yeah, what is that?

273

It's a different color than the other lights that have come through here.

274

Yeah.

Huh.

It's not moving.

277

It looks like it's moving really slow.

278

Really moving slow.

279

You want to look at it through the night vision binoculars?

280

I don't see it going from side to side.

281

Whoa.

Holy s***.

283

00:14:20,000 --> 00:14:22,000

It's coming towards us.

284

I really started to wonder, could there be a base underwater?

285

who has been gathering data of sightings off the coast of Southern California for decades,

I've been researching since 1988, and I'm going to say a good 10% of UFO sightings in this area

367

are being chased by our military jets.

And if we're chasing it, it's clearly not ours.

369

Yeah, right.

These things are coming down right over the road,

371

you know, showing themselves off to groups of people.

This is totally contrary to how the military would test their most advanced secret aircraft.

They just don't do that.

Battle of Los Angeles, back in 1942.

Huge sightings of objects come out over the ocean.

This is just after Pearl Harbor.

The whole city goes on blackout.

Multiple objects are seen.

In the early morning hours of February 5, 1942,

380

numerous UFOs were reported in the skies above Los Angeles.

Air raid sirens sounded.

A total blackout was ordered.

as the objects moved from Santa Monica to Long Beach.

USOs. There hasn't been a lot of research into it.

402

USO is Unidentified Submersible Object.

403

It's obviously the same thing as a UFO,

404

but you can't really call it a UFO if it's underwater.

I mean, there's a whole range of cases.

So I'm aware of UFOs, but USOs, this would be a first.

So this saturated area, where is it?

This area is right off the coast of Malibu.

It's highly active in this one sharply defined area.

Why? How deep is it?

418

Turns out it's an average of about 3,000 feet with areas up to a mile deep.

Because this is a place that these objects can hide very easily.

So you had the JPS coordinates to exactly where that anomaly is?

But it's unexplained as far as you're concerned.

It's definitely unidentified.

We have two audio clips, one that we can identify possible whale

813

But we do have a video that I want you to see.

This is something that Dan saw underwater.

So it's most likely not that.

And if it wasn't your dive light, then it's got to be something else.

829

When I first saw that, I thought maybe it was a reflection.

830

Well, the fact that you guys were so deep, it wouldn't reflect off the bottom, right?

831

Have you ever seen any lights like that underneath the water while you're diving?

833

I have been on a number of night dives, but I've never seen anything like this.

There's definitely something going on out here off the coast of Southern California.

The Southern California coastline has repeatedly proven to be an undeniable hotbed of UFO activity.
