Last night I experienced something I can't explain.

101

I don't know, like within the last few weeks or so.

Took a very professional approach, he was just gathering information.

Eventually, Matthew and I started talking,

In March 2009, Matthew Reed loses consciousness while tracking a strange orange light.

149

151

Matthew reports the incident to the Mutual UFO Network,

152

and former police detective Steve White takes the case.

153

Later that night, Matthew tries to put the unexplained events behind him.

154

00:09:10,000 --> 00:09:17,000

I was looking in the mirror, and I realized that in the center of my chest were these two wounds.

155

Then the memories of what just occurred started kind of flooding in.

156

I'm standing in a room, there is a moment of gathering your senses and thinking,

157

It's the walls, there's no lights.

The walls kind of just admit a light.

160

Then there was three beings that were standing a little bit off to my left,

Well, an exoplanet is a planet going around a star that's not our own sun.

Life on Earth influences the search for life elsewhere in the solar system

208

00:13:38,000 --> 00:13:41,000

by basically telling us what we think life needs.

209

So life on Earth needs energy, organic materials, and liquid water.

210

00:13:45,000 --> 00:13:50,000

If we can find exoplanets that show the conditions that we believe will be suitable for life,

211

we think these are the best potential habitats to look for.

212

Might life exist on those habitats?

213

Might life evolve on those habitats to a state where it becomes intelligent,

214

and might that life then choose to communicate?

215

We have no solid information at all on how to answer that question.

Overcome by terrifying memories,

217

Matthew reaches out to move on investigator Steve White.

There was some anxiety of what just happened.

219

When I changed the realization that there was people out there

220

that intelligently would investigate this, look at this,

and help us come to at least some sort of understanding,

that was very comforting, that was very therapeutic for me.

because I made me feel important.

I guess it was maybe about an hour after we got into bed,

247

and we were kind of goofing a little bit.

248

Stop it.

249

You feel that?

250

00:16:31,000 --> 00:16:34,000

You do this every night. It's not funny anymore.

251

Stop it.

Is it annoying you?

I remember seeing these flashes of light,

254

269

It was just lighting up the whole room.

271

Bunk beds started to rattle, and it just got loud,

272

and it was just terrifying at that age.

The next thing I know,

Tom's gone.

I remember looking over the banister.

279

There's that same sensation of just being pulled as a...

280

Then all of a sudden I'm in the crowd.

There was a constant humming and vibration in the air.

282

It wasn't like if you put your hands on the table,

283

you could feel the vibration, but you could feel it inside.

It was just like...

It was... It was rhythmic. It was a rhythm to it.
