A lot of stealthy aircraft are going to have this deltoid plan for them.

It's very, very common.

The lights are typically located on the extremity of the aircraft so that can create a very strange pattern.

125

Probably the strongest interest in trying to introduce technology to reduce the radar signature started happening in the Cold War.

126

The U-2, there were variants of that airplane where they were trying to make it much more stealthy.

127

The SR-71, the Blackbird, and its actual even darker, blacker variant of that airplane developed by the CIA called the A-12

were intentionally designed to have a much reduced radar signature and a reduced infrared signature

129

and create strange perceptions by people if they see them at night.

But everything an aircraft would do, this did not do.

Two nights later, he returns to Rendlesen Forest with a group of airmen led by Lieutenant Colonel Charles Halt.

There was more activity outside Woodbridge Base.

151

On duty flight at the time, again saw strange lights in the woods.

152

Colonel Halt was selected to lead a group of guys out into the forest to try to make sense of what was going on.

153

Colonel Halt at the time was the deputy base commander for the 81st tactical fire wing at RF Bellwaters.

He was second in command for the base.

I just wanted to know if it was back again or what we were dealing with.

Colonel Halt brought one of his little micro-set recorders with him.

And he pointed to two that looked like they were doing a grid search.

They wanted me to write a full statement. They were very adamant and clear about it.

I was intimidated. They are serious.

But then Peniston is presented with a deal he didn't bargain for.

Teen, twenty minutes later, they came back in.

They called in.

They have a type page, about a quarter of a page, maybe a little longer.

They made me read it, I think, two or three times.

225

So it was very sanitized. It was very generic.

226

They said, and this is the official story, the official account,

And if the message is consistent, then you have a code.

I sent them off to an expert in Australia, an expert on the eastern sea board of the United States.

In fact, a modern GPS system relies on being able to tell you where you are using a binary code.

The seven locations have been ciphered and they show places around the world.

479

There's a point in the American Southwest which is Sedona.

480

There's a point in Central America near Belize.

There's a point in South America near the NASCAR lines.

There's a point in Greece, a point in Egypt, and a point up in the mountains in China.

483

00:43:28,000 --> 00:43:35,000

They gave a grid cord in the west of Great Britain, which is what they call High Brazil.

484

I believe it's significant in these areas that are naturally occurring electrical magnetic areas.

485

These electromagnetic fields could be possible gateways to other dimensions.

486

If you go to these sites, there's glyphs, there's drawings on walls showing some kind of encounter with something from outer space.

487

Peniston and Burroughs now believe they experienced some kind of contact with time travelers from the future.

But the military still doesn't acknowledge that anything unusual occurred in Rendlesham Forest.
