When you think about how gold is made, naturally gold is formed basically in the nuclear reactions in the sun. And then it spreads throughout the universe when a supernova occurs and the sun explodes and sends all of the products out.

Because we now can do controlled nuclear reactions, we have the ability finally to essentially manufacture gold from other elements.

We put mercury into one of these tubes and mercury has a minor isotope of 0.15% mercury 196, its gulf. And that isotope will actually pick up a neutron and in about 23 hours turn into gold.

To bring the reactor to full capacity, Dr. Shaka removes the control rods that absorb neutrons and keep them from reacting with other atoms. This generates power at a staggering rate.

In terms of the amount of power, including electrical energy that you can generate from a given mass of material, nuclear is about 10 to 20 million times better than anything else.

133

After 24 hours, the experiment has been a success and yields gold, a real-life philosopher's stone at work in the basement of a university building.
