81

He came in the afternoon.

Leaving a name is a little bit creepy.

91

if the suicide was only last year.

We actually spent two days there walking through the forest.

The curse is nailed in.

I think this person was tortured by society.

But why?

who once came to the Aimee,

118

the original inhabitants of Japan.

She visited them and brought knowledge,

120

so it's a place of deep reverence.

121

Mount Fuji in Japan is called a world naval.

122

It is one of many places on planet Earth

123

166

Their destination, a mountain called Otorten,

168

00:10:39,700 --> 00:10:44,700

which in the local Mancy language means, do not go there.

169

00:10:46,700 --> 00:10:49,700

Among them were three experienced engineers, the rest were students.

170

00:10:49,700 --> 00:10:53,700

They were all young, but I think the oldest was like 37 years old.

171

00:10:53,700 --> 00:10:57,700

They had conducted other hard tracks to the area.

172

00:10:57,700 --> 00:11:01,700

They were all experienced, strong-willed, determined people.

173

00:11:03,700 --> 00:11:08,700

On their fourth night out, bad weather forces the hikers to camp atop an area.

174

00:11:08,700 --> 00:11:13,700

Called Kolat Siakol, which in Mancy translates to

175

00:11:13,700 --> 00:11:16,700

the mountain of the dead.

176

00:11:17,700 --> 00:11:24,700

It was a very inhospitable, very strange, very, very hard place to be.

177

00:11:24,700 --> 00:11:31,700

Snow, cold, freezing winds, and very few living things around.

178

00:11:32,700 --> 00:11:39,700

They decided that they would spend the night of February 1st in an open area,

179

00:11:39,700 --> 00:11:43,700

not too far away from the top of the mountain.

180

00:11:43,700 --> 00:11:48,700

They didn't want to go back to the forest one and a half kilometers,

181

00:11:48,700 --> 00:11:52,700

because it would take them too much time and they would lose the day.

182

00:11:55,700 --> 00:12:00,700

Ten days later, when the nine adventurers failed to show up at their death,

183

00:12:00,700 --> 00:12:04,700

military rescue teams searched the area.

184

00:12:04,700 --> 00:12:10,700

They find the hikers camp abandoned and a tent that is badly damaged.

185

00:12:10,700 --> 00:12:16,700

The investigators determined that the tent has been cut and ripped open from the inside.

186

00:12:19,700 --> 00:12:24,700

And the hikers appeared to have fled the area in only socks or bare feet.

187

This tent had been cut with knives from the interior.

188

00:12:31,700 --> 00:12:38,700

It was absolutely obvious that neither animals nor people had approached the tent to break in,

189

00:12:38,700 --> 00:12:42,700

meaning that nothing from this earth had approached them.

190

Something was pushing them to run away without taking any clothing with them,

191

00:12:51,700 --> 00:12:54,700

without taking any supplies.

192

They were behaving like they were in the days, confused.

193

The investigators followed the trail to the edge of the forest,

194

but what they eventually find is beyond belief.

All nine hikers died.

196

They were discovered by Soviet troops in various stages of what can only be described as being mutilated.

197

Their bodies were burned, some suffered radiation poisoning.

198

In one case, a hiker's tongue was missing.

199

00:13:29,700 --> 00:13:36,700

They had prematurely aged, their skin was orange, their hair turned gray.

200

What could have explained this?

201

00:13:38,700 --> 00:13:46,700

Three of them had injuries that could be sustained when somebody is hit by a speeding car.

202

Except the injuries were inside, their ribs were crushed like ax shells.

203

Some of them entered their hearts, but there was no effect on their skin.

204

It was like a force was directed at all of them.

205

An unknown force had hit the hikers, and it was very selective in hitting only the hikers,

206

00:14:13,700 --> 00:14:19,700

leaving untouched the snow, the trees and everything else around.

207

The official explanation was that the nine died from hypothermia,

208

00:14:25,700 --> 00:14:33,700

but the chief investigator refused to sign off on the report and instead resigned from the inquiry.

209

When the investigation was taking place by the local officials,

210

00:14:40,700 --> 00:14:46,700

one of the people in charge was removed quite quickly from the very investigation

211

00:14:46,700 --> 00:14:52,700

because he was very thorough and local officials didn't want this to come out.

212

00:14:54,700 --> 00:14:58,700

The authorities did their best to cover the whole thing up.

213

00:14:58,700 --> 00:15:01,700

It was practically forbidden to mention it.

214

00:15:01,700 --> 00:15:06,700

At the end, the bodies were buried in zinc coffins, I believe, so nobody would see.

215

But there was enough of the investigation, enough people had seen what had been going on

216

00:15:12,700 --> 00:15:18,700

and were amazed at what they found, including the coloration of the corpses when they were found

217

00:15:18,700 --> 00:15:21,700

and other things that news broke out.

218

And this is one of the most important things that happened in the history of the world.

219

News broke out and this is one of the most mysterious murder cases in the former Soviet Union.

220

I am convinced it was a murder, but they were not killed by anything we know.

221

They were killed by an unknown force.

222

Years later, members of the search party spoke out.

223

According to their testimony, at the time of the incident,

strange orange spheres or orbs were seen floating in the sky.

These observations are from local people who saw some unidentified flying objects

during the night of the Hiker's deaths.

The orbs themselves could have been a life form.

The orbs themselves could have been extraterrestrial probes.

Maybe it wasn't an attack as much as the power of these orbs, the energy was so intense that human beings were prematurely aged,

irradiated and suffered all kinds of lethal biological symptoms.

It's not a coincidence that UFOs were reported by these hikers in the Earl Mountains and the place of the dead,

Standing nearly 1400 feet high, the mountain consists of enormous black granite boulders piled precariously one on top of the other.

Called Calcajaqa, or mountain of death by the local aborigines,

261

00:20:00,700 --> 00:20:08,700

Black Mountain, with its numerous dark passageways and caverns, is considered a cursed and evil place.

262

What the old people told us, when me and my brother Sam, when we were going up,

263

00:20:14,700 --> 00:20:22,700

not to go into the mountains, we wanted to go and have a look into the mountains to see if there was a cave where you could walk in,

264

00:20:22,700 --> 00:20:28,700

but they said no. If you do go in, you won't come back.

265

00:20:30,700 --> 00:20:38,700

Black Mountain is the most fearful place in the north Queensland area of Australia.

266

00:20:38,700 --> 00:20:43,700

The local residents fear to go there because many people have disappeared,

267

00:20:43,700 --> 00:20:48,700

as if the earth or the mountain itself swallowed them up.
