Opposite from the famous burial chamber of King Tut, is a small crypt, KV 55.

166

It is known only by a number, because even though it was discovered over a century ago,

167

00:18:01,623 --> 00:18:04,623

no one is certain who was buried there.

168

00:18:04,623 --> 00:18:10,625

Initially, it was thought to belong to King Tut's father, Akhenaten.

169

00:18:10,625 --> 00:18:17,626

But radiological examination suggested the body belonged to a much younger man.

170

00:18:21,627 --> 00:18:27,628

This is a KV 55 in the Valley of the Kings, away from the public eye.

171

00:18:27,628 --> 00:18:34,630

Most Egyptologists and archaeologists are baffled and have a lot of questions.

172

00:18:34,630 --> 00:18:39,631

Very little is known about this term. Let's get in.

173

00:18:42,632 --> 00:18:47,633

One of the most common features of all the tombs in the Valley of the Kings

174

00:18:47,633 --> 00:18:52,634

is the amount of wall paintings on the tombs, explaining everything,

175

00:18:52,634 --> 00:18:59,635

and telling the world that this is the tomb of that king, and this is how great that king is.

176

00:18:59,635 --> 00:19:04,636

But look at this tomb, completely empty.

177

00:19:04,636 --> 00:19:11,638

In 1907, archaeologists allegedly found an ominous curse on the wall,

178

00:19:11,638 --> 00:19:18,639

assuring that whoever occupied this tomb would not return in a subsequent life.

179

00:19:18,639 --> 00:19:25,641

When they first opened this tomb, they found little remains of hieroglyphics on this wall

180

00:19:25,641 --> 00:19:30,642

that says that evil one should not live again.

181

00:19:33,643 --> 00:19:41,644

Inside, archaeologists found a coffin with the remains of a mummified body within a long-gated head.

182

00:19:41,644 --> 00:19:45,645

The right side of its skull was smashed in.

183

But perhaps the most striking feature of the tomb is that unlike all other tombs in the Valley,

184

00:19:52,647 --> 00:19:55,647

it was not built to keep grave robbers out.

185

00:19:55,647 --> 00:20:02,649

It was built specifically to keep someone, or something, trapped inside.

186

00:20:02,649 --> 00:20:06,650

This is the burial chamber of the tomb.

187

00:20:06,650 --> 00:20:11,651

Right here is exactly where the sarcophagus would have gone.

188

00:20:15,652 --> 00:20:21,653

And to north, south, east, and west of the sarcophagus

189

00:20:21,653 --> 00:20:29,655

were the four magical cardinal blocks that protects the tomb from any intruders.

190

00:20:32,655 --> 00:20:41,657

This is a part of some of the magical blocks that surrounded the sarcophagus.

191

00:20:41,657 --> 00:20:48,659

These rocks in every other tomb had inscriptions on the outside, on the side facing the world,

192

00:20:48,659 --> 00:20:52,660

so it protects the tomb from the world except for this tomb.

193

00:20:52,660 --> 00:20:59,661

This tomb, the rocks had hieroglyphics with the inscriptions on the inside,

194

00:20:59,661 --> 00:21:06,663

as if they intentionally wanted to protect the outside world from the contents of this tomb.

195

The ancient Egyptians were strong believers in reincarnation

196

00:21:12,664 --> 00:21:19,665

and even had a specific name for the part of the individual that detaches itself from the body after death.

197

They referred to it as ba.

198

00:21:23,666 --> 00:21:28,667

The ba is the personality, the ba is the character.

199

Every human had a ba, and the ba is the part they believed moves out

200

and is reincarnated in another life, another living human.

Ancient astronaut theorists suggest that the concept of what the Egyptians referred to as the ba

202

or the detachment of the spirit from the body has been depicted in artwork throughout history.

Across the globe, over 1.5 billion people believe in reincarnation,

In the Kabbalistic tradition of Judaism, reincarnation is considered a fundamental belief.

The early Christian belief in reincarnation was eventually declared a heresy.

Instead of recycling to earth over and over again, you now only have one destination after this life.

217

That destination is either heaven or it's hell, depending on how you behaved in life.

It was used as a control mechanism.

219

In ancient Greece, Socrates, Pythagoras, and Plato all commented on the possibility of reincarnation.

and that the living spring from the dead. So here's a strong sense of reincarnation.
