a formula which calculates the amount of velocity needed to lift a body into outer space.

Incredibly, his theories would prove instrumental in helping the Soviet Union launch the first man-made object into orbit more than 50 years later.

Konstantin Salkovsky wasn't a classically trained scientist.

195

He was a secondary school math teacher, but he was so enamored with getting into space that he created the rocket science and mathematics

in the early 1900s that led to the first thing created by humanity to be launched into space, Sputnik.

To put into perspective how influential Salkovsky's work was,

198

this is the basis work that everybody had to use later.

Von Braun used it during his research on rockets, and most of the world sees the Salkovsky rocket equation as the beginning of modern rocket science.

Salkovsky was self-educated, so he had no resources, no abilities to go to some universities.

Russian Cosmism began in the mid- and late-19th century.
