Rising to an elevation of 14,179 feet, Mount Shasta in Northern California

This majestic peak, which is also a dormant volcano,

But the Native Americans who are indigenous to this area

For centuries, the mountain has been known as a place where people report strange events

Each revere Mount Shasta as a place that possesses mystical powers.

I was told by my grandmother and grandfather that we didn't go up on the tree line.

62

That belongs to grandfather up there. So I try to stay as far away as I can.

63

There was a Native American author there, Lucy Thompson, 1916.

64

She writes a book all about the Native American legends of the star people, all that activity at Mount Shasta.

65

And this isn't some like kooky book or something. She's writing the history of her people, the Yurok tribe.

66

All these legends are incredible. And this has been going on at Mount Shasta for hundreds of years.

So can we attribute all these legends to mere coincidence? That's the big question.

Another layer to this mystery is that Shasta is very close to Petroglyph Point,

60 miles northeast of Mount Shasta, at Lava Beds National Monument,

a curious record of Native American traditions can be found.

Hundreds of stone carvings, known as Petroglyphs, that were created as much as 6,000 years ago by ancestors of the Modoc tribe.

74

The Lava Beds Petroglyphs include ancient calendars, depictions of animals, humans,

75

00:06:19,000 --> 00:06:24,000

and celestial beings also referred to as sky people.

76

In various Native American traditions, we have different spiritual beings located on these sort of different planes of existence.

77

And there's a wonderful range of stories in many, many Native American groups that talk about some of the adventures

78

and interactions with the sky people, with the humans on Earth.

79

One of the Petroglyphs depicts a large winged creature emerging from inside of Mount Shasta.

80

It is believed to represent a sky being, who the Modoc people worship as their creator known as Skel.

81

The local people believe that in ancient times, the great sky chief Skel came down from the sky to live in Shasta

82

and has been there ever since and protects it.

83

Could this Petroglyph of Skel be, as some believe, an actual depiction of an extraterrestrial being that the Modoc people encountered centuries ago?

84

So we know there's been humans going through this area for a long time in creating these Petroglyphs with these mystery teachings on it.

85

So it's got all of that mythology attached to it and has all kinds of UFO sightings as well.

86

Certain mountains are associated with UFOs and Mount Shasta is definitely one of them.

87

It's interesting to me that we have modern accounts of UFO sightings, for example, right here at Mount Shasta.

But what's fascinating to me is that there are many, many ancient stories of so-called UFO encounters that we consider today UFO encounters.

Right? And are UFOs typically seen kind of coming from the top, the crater of Mount Shasta and going up?

Or are they coming out of the side? What are the beliefs there?

From all over. It's like they're coming out of the mountain or they're seen hovering above it. It's very strange.

92

Over the past century, there have been more than 50 reports of UFO sightings around Mount Shasta, with an increasing number in just the last decade.

Almost everyone who lives there has seen something unusual.

94

One of the most remarkable UFO sightings I've heard of took place in 2008.

95

Witnesses in the town of McLeod saw a UFO that looked like a giant glowing jellyfish, move over the town and then fly off into the distance.

I was driving back from Clamah Falls around 7, 6.37 in the evening and in summertime.

97

All of a sudden, I looked up on the mountain and I seen the whole mountain toward Wairoika side open up.

And then this big ship came and sat there and hovered for a minute and then went right in.

99

And the next thing you know, the mountain closed and I was like, what is going on?

100

I never let things like that bother me, though. I've seen things like that all the time.

101

And you know what's interesting about it too is that the Native Americans, there was a group of spiritual beings called the Waga that first came to Shasta and started instructing the local Native Americans.

And they told the story that there were giants that lived in Mount Shasta.

Giants are often associated with the stories of Bigfoot.

104

Absolutely.

And Mount Shasta is also famous for Bigfoot sightings.

Yes, it is.

In fact, the earliest really popular sightings of Bigfoot and where the name Bigfoot comes from is from Northern California and around Redding.

Giants? Bigfoot?

Incredibly, similar stories have been reported in this area for hundreds of years.

And in October 1930, several newspapers detailed the discovery of a mysteriously large humanoid skeleton in the town of Redding, 60 miles south of Mount Shasta.

There are traditions of giants linked with Mount Shasta, which absolutely fascinate me.

And one of these goes back quite a long way and it's part of the Madoch tribe who are kind of part of this area.

And they say the sky spirit's daughter was abducted by a bear and she actually gave birth to a race of giants.

Some people suggest that these are actually hairy beast, such what? Like beings connected with Mount Shasta.

So you've got this convergence of these stories of massive UFO sightings, giants, star beings.

116

This is like a hotbed area up here. It is incredible.

117

Native Americans in that area around Mount Shasta warn people of the number of disappearances that have taken place up there.

118

So Mount Shasta is one of these hot spots for disappearing people then?

119

Exactly.

120

Native Americans in that area around Mount Shasta say that the area above the tree line is sacred and they warn people do not go up there.

121

Is that so?

Right, which makes it not surprising to learn of the number of disappearances that have taken place up there.

123

So Mount Shasta is one of these hot spots for disappearing people then?

Exactly.

Yes, Siskiyou County is the location that Carl disappeared in.

Since 2009, former police detective Dave Politis has been applying his professional investigative training,

127

attempting to solve mysterious missing persons cases all around the country.

128

In 10 plus years, I've looked at over 5,000 search and rescue cases and in those 1,200 are unexplained.

129

And I mean that cases of possible animal predation have been vetted out.

130

Incidents of mental health, suicide were vetted out.

131

And what you're left with is a complete void of rational explanation.

The area around Mount Shasta has many unusual disappearances.

133

One of the most baffling disappearances that Dave has been focusing on was reported on Mount Shasta in 1999.

134

On May 25th, three experienced hikers, Carl Landers, Milt Gaines and Barry Gilmore, set off from Mount Shasta's Bunny Flat trailhead towards the summit.

135

The guys got up to a place called 5050.

136

00:13:17,000 --> 00:13:23,000

It was a place where hikers that wanted to summit would either camp there at the next stop called Lake Helen for the night.

137

00:13:24,000 --> 00:13:27,000

The next morning they get up, the winds howling.

138

00:13:27,000 --> 00:13:35,000

The guys were putting the tent together and were stashing it for their climb and they saw that Carl was looking cold.

139

00:13:35,000 --> 00:13:39,000

And so they said, hey, why don't you go to Lake Helen's and we'll meet you there.

140

00:13:41,000 --> 00:13:43,000

And Carl took off walking.

141

00:13:46,000 --> 00:13:51,000

Shortly after Carl left the 5050 campsite, Milt and Barry followed.

142

00:13:53,000 --> 00:14:01,000

But when they arrived at Lake Helen just 650 feet away, Carl was nowhere to be found.

143

00:14:04,000 --> 00:14:09,000

Milt Gaines, Carl's partner, got there and he didn't see Carl.

144

00:14:09,000 --> 00:14:17,000

And now he's confused because there's no place between 5050 and Lake Helen to disappear.

145

00:14:18,000 --> 00:14:20,000

There's no obstructions. You're above Timberline.

146

00:14:20,000 --> 00:14:23,000

There's no big, huge boulders that are going to get in your way.

147

00:14:23,000 --> 00:14:27,000

And it's a solid snow field with no crevices.

148

00:14:30,000 --> 00:14:36,000

And that started a week-long search and rescue that would rival any anyone knew about.

149

00:14:36,000 --> 00:14:45,000

Now one of the things that was done on the Landers case is that they checked with U.S. Geological Survey for seismic activity on the mountain.

150

00:14:45,000 --> 00:14:51,000

The reason they did that is that sometimes there's an avalanche of rock

151

00:14:51,000 --> 00:14:55,000

and maybe the climber was covered by the rock and you wouldn't find him.

152

00:14:55,000 --> 00:14:59,000

Now during the time that Carl was gone, there was no seismic activity.

153

00:14:59,000 --> 00:15:02,000

So they know that Carl wasn't covered by rocks.

154

00:15:04,000 --> 00:15:08,000

Remarkably, in the more than 20 years since Carl's disappearance,

155

00:15:08,000 --> 00:15:13,000

no one has found any clues that could explain what happened to him.

156

00:15:15,000 --> 00:15:18,000

I don't know how many people have been up avalanche cults.

157

00:15:18,000 --> 00:15:23,000

But nothing has been found. No metal ice-axe, no metal crampons,

158

00:15:23,000 --> 00:15:31,000

no colorful nylon pack or coat or black pants or plastic boots. Nothing.

159

00:15:33,000 --> 00:15:38,000

The search and rescue coordinator on this event was an individual named Griz Adams.

160

00:15:38,000 --> 00:15:41,000

Griz had been doing this for 30-plus years.

161

00:15:41,000 --> 00:15:46,000

Griz said, Dave, I guarantee Carl isn't on that mountain.

162

00:15:46,000 --> 00:15:51,000

He either went up or he went in, but he isn't on.

163

00:15:51,000 --> 00:15:53,000

Those were his words.

164

00:15:54,000 --> 00:16:01,000

I think that the comment tells you that there were a few options for a rational explanation.

165

00:16:03,000 --> 00:16:06,000

So they never found him, they have no explanation for what happened.

166

00:16:06,000 --> 00:16:08,000

Everyone's just baffled.

167

00:16:08,000 --> 00:16:12,000

No, he's hiking up the mountain inside of his friends and suddenly disappears.

168

00:16:12,000 --> 00:16:18,000

And do they see him disappear or they just look away and they turn around and he's gone?

169

00:16:18,000 --> 00:16:22,000

Typically in those stories, people don't actually see them disappear,

170

00:16:22,000 --> 00:16:25,000

but they're nearby and they never call out for help or anything like that.

171

00:16:25,000 --> 00:16:27,000

Then there's a story about a three-year-old boy.

172

00:16:27,000 --> 00:16:32,000

He's camping with his parents on Chasta and he wanders off, disappears.

173

00:16:33,000 --> 00:16:39,000

Another very unusual disappearance that Dave Politis investigated near Mount Chasta

174

00:16:39,000 --> 00:16:43,000

occurred on September 2nd, 2011.

175

00:16:44,000 --> 00:16:47,000

A three-year-old boy disappeared on a camping trip

176

00:16:47,000 --> 00:16:55,000

and he was later found by search and rescue at one of the first places they would have looked, right next to a trail.

177

00:16:55,000 --> 00:17:01,000

One of the first things search and rescue people do is as they're walking down a trail,

178

00:17:01,000 --> 00:17:03,000

they're calling the boy's name.

179

00:17:06,000 --> 00:17:12,000

Now if he was near the trail and he heard that, chances are he's going to come and get help

180

00:17:12,000 --> 00:17:14,000

because he'd been out there overnight.

181

00:17:14,000 --> 00:17:18,000

So to think that he was next to that trail the whole time is really hard to understand.

182

00:17:19,000 --> 00:17:26,000

Another unusual aspect to that story is that this boy told a story of after going missing,

183

00:17:26,000 --> 00:17:30,000

he was down in some kind of underground cave.

184

00:17:32,000 --> 00:17:41,000

And a woman, but he thought was a robot, was there asking him if he was okay and comfortable.

185

00:17:41,000 --> 00:17:46,000

It was all a very strange story, something I've never heard before.

186

00:17:46,000 --> 00:17:51,000

While the story may sound like the product of a child's imagination,

187

00:17:51,000 --> 00:17:57,000

the search and rescue team could provide no explanation for how the boy went missing for five hours,

188

00:17:58,000 --> 00:18:01,000

only to suddenly turn up right next to the trail.

189

00:18:03,000 --> 00:18:07,000

Many people say these disappearances are just accidents,

190

00:18:07,000 --> 00:18:13,000

but the idea that somebody disappears in a location where there are UFO sightings

191

00:18:13,000 --> 00:18:20,000

and sometimes reports of entities mirrors the idea perhaps of the alien abduction.

192

Is it possible that Karl Landers and others who mysteriously disappeared around

193

00:18:26,000 --> 00:18:31,000

Mount Shasta were abducted by extraterrestrial beings?

194

Or might there be an even more profound explanation?

195

00:18:36,000 --> 00:18:39,000

People are still disappearing on Mount Shasta.

196

00:18:39,000 --> 00:18:43,000

This is not something that has stopped.

197

00:18:43,000 --> 00:18:48,000

And it's an open area where there's not that many places to hide except by going inside the mountain.

198

00:18:48,000 --> 00:18:54,000

Absolutely, but once again this affirms the mystery, the strangeness of Mount Shasta

199

00:18:54,000 --> 00:18:59,000

and says there's a lot more going on here than we really realize.

200

People are called to Mount Shasta and they don't know why.

201

Mount Shasta is also apparently on a major lay line.

202

They're a telluric current of energy going from different grid spots and power spots.

What's going on in Mount Shasta is not just in North America.

204

All over the world are these power spot mountains like Mount Shasta.

205

Mount Shasta is sometimes said to be one of the chakras of the planet too.

206

The ancient Sanskrit term chakra refers to energy centers in the human body.

207

In his 1967 book, Earth Chakras,

208

00:19:42,000 --> 00:19:47,000

author Robert Kuhn proposed that the planet also has energy centers

209

00:19:47,000 --> 00:19:52,000

and that these act as connection points to other worldly dimensions.

His list included Mount Sinai in Egypt,

211

Mount Kailash in Tibet,

and Mount Shasta.

There are traditions of sacred mountains all over the world.

214

This is where the gods came down, started civilization,

215

but it's also thought to be where communication with the gods took place,

216

00:20:15,000 --> 00:20:22,000

and potentially where interstellar travel may have taken place between this world and other worlds.

217

It seems that Mount Shasta is on some energy line that's perhaps connected even to Kuzko and Lake Titicaca,

218

the great pyramids, you know, power spots, sacred places.

219

Yeah, it's important to bring up the great pyramid because it reminds me of Mount Shasta.

220

Really?

221

00:20:40,000 --> 00:20:41,000

Okay.

222

00:20:42,000 --> 00:20:47,000

First of all, it's a volcano, and the word pyramid means fire in the middle.

223

And underneath the great pyramid are tunnels.

224

Same thing here at Shasta.

225

00:20:55,000 --> 00:21:02,000

And it makes me think, well, maybe Shasta could have been like the natural origin of the idea of the pyramid as like a power center.

226

But the pyramid is an artificial construction.

227

00:21:05,000 --> 00:21:07,000

A lava tube is not artificial.

228

00:21:07,000 --> 00:21:15,000

Exactly what I'm saying is that perhaps the pyramid is kind of like a technological version of a naturally occurring power center like a volcano.

229

The great pyramid of Giza?

230

A power center?

231
