Colonel Alexander says he was part of this unofficial panel that investigated UFOs.

292

And he had access to information the public doesn't and we want to get his perspective.

293

If you could stand at a podium on world television to talk about UFOs, what would you say?

294

Simple. UFOs are real and we need to make it permissible for scientists to study them without risking their career or livelihood.

That's a pretty bold statement from someone in your position.

Some people have claimed that we're moving from a period of small-scale individual sightings to larger-scale mass sightings.

Would you agree with that?

301

There have been mass sightings kind of all along. It can take a go back to Washington in the 50s.

302

We do know mass hysteria does play a role. We have to understand those sorts of things. It is contagious.

303

But when you start correlating that with photographic data that can be substantiated,

then you start to get cases in which the hard data say there was a physical event that took place at that time and place.

So according to Jonathan Alexander, there's a lot of weight that you can put behind mass sightings

because it allows you to cross-reference people's stories and tease out what the truth is.

So with that in mind, we're going to the Stephenville airport.

316

We're going to meet with another one of the witnesses we met at the town hall meeting, Steve Allen,

317

and we're going to talk to him about the sighting he had at his friend's house at Sunset.

318

Hey, how y'all doing? Steve Allen.

319

Steve Allen is a pilot and pilots are better trained observers to know what's conventional and unconventional.

320

It flies around in our airspace.

321

I completely trust his credibility to describe to me what he saw that night.

322

From the very beginning, can you talk us through your sighting and what you saw?

323

Sure. This was not a shooting star out in the atmosphere. It was up close and personal.

324

As it came past us, it had seven lights flashing across the back.

325

Never seen any lights that color nor that size of the lights was the size of a small pickup truck.

326

And they all stayed at the same altitude and the same distance.

327

How big was it, Steve?

328

My estimations is it's about a half a mile wide and a mile long. It was giant.

329

Even for pilots, it's really hard to determine a distant object's size, its altitude, its true distance, particularly at night.

330

So we're going to send a couple planes up and test the concept that maybe the mass sighting here in Stephenville was a case of mistaken identification.

Can multiple planes flying in formation be mistaken for a single object?

Do you see how tightly they're flying?

333

It looks like two planes almost attached together.

335

Witnesses have described the objects that they see as being silent while they move.

336

So I'm going to have our planes fly right overhead and see if we can hear them.

337

Okay guys, we are in formation. Do you guys copy?

338

00:25:19,000 --> 00:25:22,000

Copy that. We are tracking you right now on sticks.

339

00:25:24,000 --> 00:25:26,000

Those guys are tight formation.

340

00:25:26,000 --> 00:25:29,000

So imagine that this is at night and you've got running lights and beacons.

341

And then imagine if one of the two planes peeled away, it would look like there is one object with multiple blinking lights.

342

It suddenly becomes two and then it's one again.

343

So flying information, our two aircraft look like one single object.

344

And if this is something we can see during the day, it's not hard to imagine multiple aircraft flying information at night.

345

It could be mistaken as one single craft.

346

00:25:48,000 --> 00:25:53,000

If they were coming towards you with their lights on, it could theoretically look like one craft.

347

These guys are good pilots.

348

Do you guys copy? Copy that.

349

We are at C-40 closing fast.

350

Love to.

Okay, copy that.

352

00:26:10,000 --> 00:26:15,000

Van, they are coming in directly from the south at about 50 degrees.

353

00:26:16,000 --> 00:26:18,000

What's your altitude, Ryder?

354

00:26:18,000 --> 00:26:21,000

We are at 7,000 feet above the ground.

355

00:26:21,000 --> 00:26:23,000

Okay, so we've got 4,000 feet above the ground.

356

00:26:23,000 --> 00:26:25,000

Listen to how loud these planes are right now.

357

00:26:25,000 --> 00:26:29,000

And C-Val said he couldn't hear a thing and it was up close and personal.

358

At 4,000 feet, the plane's made a lot of noise. There's no mistaking that.

359

00:26:40,000 --> 00:26:45,000

So while we were able to show that multiple aircraft flying information can be mistaken as a single object,

360

you're not going to have an aircraft come right over you and not make a sound.

361

Alright Ryder, I think we've got a mission accomplished.

362

Why don't you bring our info and landing? Over.

363

Okay guys, they're coming in.

They're back.

365

Wow, what is going on?

366

00:27:09,000 --> 00:27:11,000

Four knots in a row.

367

Okay guys, they're coming in.

Ah!

369

And I just lost my lunch.

370

Now that was one hell of a flyby over.

371

Looks like Ryder got a dose for vitamin G today.

372

Touchdown.

Roger James, the Ryder has landed.

374

Even with our aerial tests complete, we still have loads and loads of questions.

375

So our next step is to meet with a man who says he's videotaped an unidentified flying object

376

00:27:56,000 --> 00:27:59,000

just three months after the mass sighting.

377

April of 2008, a man named Mauricio Ruiz captured something in the sky above his neighbor's house.

378

00:28:10,000 --> 00:28:12,000

It looks almost like a saucer in the sky.

379

00:28:12,000 --> 00:28:13,000

Almost.

380

00:28:13,000 --> 00:28:18,000

Very rarely do you have video footage where you have broad daylight, you have points of reference,

381

00:28:18,000 --> 00:28:20,000

you have something that's clearly in focus.

382

00:28:20,000 --> 00:28:25,000

So this gives us a lot to go on and I'm very much looking forward to meeting this guy and finding out more.

383

00:28:25,000 --> 00:28:27,000

Burgers flew across the screen right there.

384

00:28:28,000 --> 00:28:32,000

There's a lot of context to this, really able to get an idea of what size this is.

385

00:28:32,000 --> 00:28:35,000

Unfortunately, it looks kind of small.

386

00:28:35,000 --> 00:28:39,000

The interesting thing about this video is that it was shot just three months after the mass sighting.

387

But it doesn't really resemble the object that the people in Stephenville say that they saw.

388

Were there any other witnesses?

389

As of right now, he says no one else has come forward.

390

I'd be interested to see what he thinks the dimensions are.

391

So right off the bat, I'm a little suspicious about this video because the geometry looks all wrong to me.

392

So I really want to talk to the guy who shot it and see what it looked like to him.

393

That particular there, remember, it was kind of misty, foggy.

394

But the object itself, something I'd never seen before, it cut me off guard and I just couldn't relate to it.

To me, it's still clearly within the realm of possibility that this is a little remote controlled craft that somebody is flying around the neighborhood.

410

Well, what's on the film is a flying object that was hovering, that was noiseless.

I just don't know if it's a human hand or an alien.

This is a fairly serious guy. He's a family man. He's a church going.

He feels at least he's captured a genuine UFO on camera.

415

Since the 2008 sightings were such big news, Ben and I decided to kick it old school and do some research at the local library.

416

You start pouring through articles and I'll start looking at the histories and we'll see what we can dig up.

417

Yeah, exactly.

418

And even though there were widespread UFO sightings around the time of the incident, not many

people got close to the unidentified object.

419

So James is going to meet up with Ricky Sorals, who we met at the town hall to get more details on the craft that he claims to have been just 300 feet away from.

420

So tell me about your sighting. What happened?

421

I took off on my place to go hunting.

422

I was trying to get to this fence line before the sun went down. I had about 45 minutes left.

I get tangled up in some briars. As I'm trying to get untangled, I look up and I'm like, what in the world is this?

424

I actually lift my rifle, look at it to the scope.

James, I saw something so big that you could probably land an airplane on it.

426

When it's lightning, you can see the dark object. It's like a cigar shape. The length is about 3 to 4 feet long.

427

We've been tracking it for about 3-4 minutes now.

428

So tell me about your sighting. What did you see?

429

James, I saw something so big that you could probably land an airplane on it. I've never seen anything like it.

430

Tell me what it's like, a piece of tin that's weathered or barn wood, that color gray.

431

I'm a machinist and I've welded my whole life, but it's not like any metal I'd seen before.

432

No seams, no bolts, no welds.

433

00:32:40,000 --> 00:32:46,000

I'm watching it. I actually saw it take off and being flat 300 foot above me to nothing.

434

If I would have blinked, I would have missed it.

435

00:32:50,000 --> 00:33:00,000

I've investigated a lot of UFO cases and anyone who's gotten close enough to actually report what the actual texture of the craft, to me, is a really rare sighting.

436

If I would have heard something like this and hadn't seen it myself, I'd say, yeah, they're full of doggy ditty.

437

But since it's happened to me, it's something that's very real to me and I know what I saw.

Why are you coming forward?

439

I don't find out what it is.

Death records, cemetery, public library.

441

With James out following up with Ricky Sorrell's, Ben and I were doing research at the local library.

442

We're hoping to comb through some newspaper articles to see if we can dig up any new information or leads to follow up on.

443

I've got something.

444

00:33:43,000 --> 00:33:44,000

What'd you find?

445

June 20th, 1891, check this out.

446

00:33:47,000 --> 00:33:54,000

Quite a little excitement was created last Saturday night by the meteoric explosion near Wasson and Miller's gin.

447

00:33:54,000 --> 00:33:55,000

Wow.

448

00:33:55,000 --> 00:33:59,000

It was more than 300 feet in the air before bursting.

449

00:33:59,000 --> 00:34:05,000

It was utterly impossible to obtain an accurate account of the dimensions and general appearance of this rare phenomenon.

450

00:34:05,000 --> 00:34:10,000

Preceding the explosion, witnesses reported seeing strange glowing white lights in the sky.

451

00:34:11,000 --> 00:34:13,000

That sounds like the 2008 sighting.

452

00:34:14,000 --> 00:34:19,000

Also discovering a number of peculiar stones and pieces of metal, all of a lead in color.

453

00:34:20,000 --> 00:34:21,000

Wow.

454

00:34:21,000 --> 00:34:24,000

Very little time was spent in scientific investigations.

455

00:34:25,000 --> 00:34:26,000

No one studied what it was.

456

00:34:26,000 --> 00:34:27,000

No.

457

00:34:28,000 --> 00:34:30,000

There could be other debris still out there.

458

00:34:31,000 --> 00:34:38,000

On the night of June 20th, 1891, the residents of Stephenville, Texas reported strange lights throughout the sky.

459

00:34:38,000 --> 00:34:44,000

Then, hours later, an object exploded, emitting debris all over the Grist Mill.

460

00:34:44,000 --> 00:34:49,000

The locals say that the ground was charred and that there was this gray, metal-like debris everywhere.

461

00:34:51,000 --> 00:34:54,000

Did you actually read the article or interpretation of the article?

462

00:34:54,000 --> 00:34:57,000

No, it was the actual article from 1891.

463

00:34:57,000 --> 00:34:58,000

1891?

464

00:34:58,000 --> 00:34:59,000

Yeah.

465

00:34:59,000 --> 00:35:06,000

In 1891, there weren't any man-made flying objects, period, which leads me to believe that whatever was seen and reported

466

00:35:06,000 --> 00:35:08,000

could have been something from another world.

467

00:35:10,000 --> 00:35:11,000

I'm interested to get out there.

468

00:35:11,000 --> 00:35:16,000

This is certainly the oldest legend crash site that I've ever been tasked with investigating.

469

00:35:16,000 --> 00:35:18,000

Let me ask you really quickly, Ben.

470

00:35:18,000 --> 00:35:24,000

So if something did crash there as reported, do you think 100 years later there'll be physical evidence?

471

00:35:24,000 --> 00:35:27,000

I mean, these are very specific sorts of things that you can look for.

472

00:35:27,000 --> 00:35:34,000

Granted, it's been a long time, but lead and appearance metal fragments, the article that we found describes a fire in the area.

473

00:35:34,000 --> 00:35:37,000

We can look for evidence of old burns and soil horizons.

474

00:35:37,000 --> 00:35:42,000

We can look for evidence of topographic depressions in the area that might indicate an impact of some kind.

475

00:35:42,000 --> 00:35:46,000

I think it's a chance for us to get our hands dirty and find some physical evidence.

476

00:35:48,000 --> 00:35:50,000

So we're heading out to the old Grist Mill.

477

00:35:50,000 --> 00:35:55,000

We already know we're going to be fighting daylight, and it's probably going to be a little dangerous poking around out there in the dark,

478

00:35:55,000 --> 00:36:01,000

but we have to do everything we can to collect any evidence at all to let us know what really happened out here.

479

00:36:05,000 --> 00:36:11,000

Alright. This looks like the topographic low point here.

480

00:36:11,000 --> 00:36:15,000

You know, what can we look for? We can look to corroborate different elements of the story.

481

00:36:15,000 --> 00:36:22,000

We're looking for metallic fragments, we'll look for any ash deposits that might indicate an old historical fire in this area.

482

00:36:22,000 --> 00:36:27,000

James, why don't we have you start over by the mill, do a surface recon with the metal detector.

483

00:36:27,000 --> 00:36:30,000

Start there, work your way towards us.

484

00:36:30,000 --> 00:36:33,000

Alright, well, night's a-wastin'. Let's get to it.

485

00:36:35,000 --> 00:36:47,000

According to the newspaper article from 1891, there was an explosion of some unknown flying object,

486

00:36:47,000 --> 00:36:55,000

and it exploded into little bits of metal, and according to geologist Ben, whatever it was,

487

00:36:55,000 --> 00:37:00,000

there'll be evidence of it 100 years later. So that is what we're looking for.

488

00:37:05,000 --> 00:37:12,000

If you want to start with the radiation survey, I can start picking out prime locations for soil sampling.

489

00:37:12,000 --> 00:37:17,000

A radiation survey could detect evidence if a nuclear reactor had been nearby.

490

00:37:17,000 --> 00:37:18,000

Sounds great.

491

00:37:18,000 --> 00:37:23,000

Right now, I'm setting up our preliminary survey grid.

492

00:37:23,000 --> 00:37:26,000

The total station is just getting a sense for the area right now,

493

00:37:26,000 --> 00:37:33,000

and we'll use this to be able to set up our reference grid so we know where we're going to be getting data.

494
