146

He ran during the war to develop insects, ticks, and so forth for biological warfare.

149

In Germany, Eric Traub worked for Heinrich Himmler, who ran Hitler's Gestapo and SS.

It was Traub's idea to inject animal diseases into ticks, then release the ticks as an army of bio weapons.

Traub was brought to the States after the war under Operation Paperclip, a U.S. government program that recruited Nazi scientists.

The Dr. Mengele types don't get so much attention.

The governor and Alex Piper have chartered their own boat to the mysterious Animal Research Lab.

325

Their navigator is Jim McCoy.

326

00:24:51,000 --> 00:25:00,000

He worked on Plum Island until he blew the whistle on dangerous sloppy practices that could lead to bio-warfare outbreaks and mass casualties.

327

He lost his job. He won the lawsuit.

328

I got a boat with a captain who's going to take us over.

Because it is such a deadly virus.

Deadly not in the sense that it kills,

349

00:26:43,000 --> 00:26:49,000

but in the sense that it takes so few virus particles to infect animals.

350

Consequences of an infection are just horrendous for the whole economy

351

00:26:54,000 --> 00:27:00,000

because it immediately shuts down export of beef to the rest of the world.

352

00:27:02,000 --> 00:27:05,000

The same thing happened in England in 2001.

353

The first effect is a quarantine.

354

00:27:07,000 --> 00:27:10,000

Something like three to five mile radius.

355

So the effects would be catastrophic.

356

They would be.

357

Everybody you talk to around here sets this place up like it's the incubator for germ warfare,

358

biological warfare.

I mean, this is ground zero.

360

The fact that they won't even take you out on the boat says everything that you need to know.

What idea to be funny with you?

394

The Coast Guard is hot on the tail of Jesse Ventura as he attempts to reach Plum Island.

395

00:30:15,000 --> 00:30:18,000

Word is out that he's accompanied by Jim McCoy,

396

00:30:18,000 --> 00:30:24,000

a Plum Island worker who was fired after he blew the whistle on dangerous safety violations.

397

00:30:26,000 --> 00:30:29,000

Well, yeah, this Coast Guard boat's definitely following us.

398

00:30:29,000 --> 00:30:30,000

Look at that.

399

00:30:30,000 --> 00:30:31,000

Yeah.

400

00:30:32,000 --> 00:30:36,000

We got the Coast Guard behind us. We got these guys here. What the hell?

401

00:30:36,000 --> 00:30:40,000

I used to be a governor. What do they think I am? A fucking terrorist?

402

00:30:41,000 --> 00:30:47,000

The Coast Guard boats stayed in sight the entire time, but they didn't stop us.

403

Before we knew it, we were at Plum Island.

404

What was your job here?

405

My job was in the Bio Level 3 containment laboratory.

You got fired?

Yes, I did.

What did you do to get fired?

409

00:31:07,000 --> 00:31:15,000

I had interrupted a meeting in the administration building that was attended by the then acting director for Homeland Security,

410

00:31:15,000 --> 00:31:23,000

Senator Clinton's New York manager, as well as other representatives, aides, and environmental groups.

411

00:31:23,000 --> 00:31:26,000

And you interrupted their meeting and what did you do?

412

00:31:26,000 --> 00:31:34,000

I asked to speak because I had safety issues that I'd observed on Plum Island and I wanted to discuss them with them.

413

00:31:34,000 --> 00:31:43,000

There was no level of security monitoring inside the bio containment area.

414

00:31:43,000 --> 00:31:47,000

So you brought these facts up and you were fired over it?

415

00:31:47,000 --> 00:31:48,000

Yes, sir.

416

00:31:48,000 --> 00:31:54,000

I felt that from the safety of the people that worked there, for the people who lived in this community,

417

00:31:54,000 --> 00:32:00,000

and for our country, that these things had to be told, even if it meant my job.

418

00:32:01,000 --> 00:32:10,000

Jim McCoy knew where all the bodies were buried and where bodies and bio weapons may have escaped.

419

00:32:10,000 --> 00:32:12,000

What are those buildings right there?

420

00:32:12,000 --> 00:32:22,000

They used to keep their livestock in pens there and there was talk when I worked at the lab that a cow that was injected with the virus got out

421

00:32:22,000 --> 00:32:28,000

and got into the pen with all the other cows and they had to kill all the cows.

422

00:32:30,000 --> 00:32:36,000

The long building with all the stacks sticking up, that is the bio containment laboratory.

423

In the event of a power failure to the island, the generators will kick on.

424

And that is something that didn't happen in December of 2002.

425

There was a period of four hours that they lost power from the mainland.

426

During this time, they had no ventilation to the bio containment area to ensure that the viruses would be kept in a negative pressure.

427

Pretty dangerous.

428

Yes. The people were going around putting duct tape around the outside doors on the bio containment area and trying to contain whatever might be getting out into the atmosphere.

439

I'm a former governor, a former mayor, a former Navy SEAL with a top secret security clearance.

Yet, I can't go on Plum Island.

441

I get the Coast Guard tailing me.

442

00:34:05,000 --> 00:34:09,000

I get vehicles along the shore watching our every move.

443

Where I come from, if you're the one paying the money, that makes you the boss.

444

00:34:14,000 --> 00:34:18,000

How come we the people aren't the boss anymore?

445

00:34:19,000 --> 00:34:22,000

We're the one paying the salaries of these people,

446

00:34:22,000 --> 00:34:27,000

and yet they deprive us of knowing what they do on this island.

447

00:34:27,000 --> 00:34:29,000

They want to get heavy?

448

00:34:29,000 --> 00:34:32,000

I can give as good as I get.

449

00:34:34,000 --> 00:34:37,000

Next stop, Washington, D.C.

450

00:34:37,000 --> 00:34:40,000

I paid a visit to Congressman Tim Bishop.

451

00:34:40,000 --> 00:34:45,000

If there's anyone who'd know what's going on at Plum Island, this is the guy.

452

00:34:45,000 --> 00:34:47,000

Plum Island's in his district.

453

00:34:47,000 --> 00:34:53,000

He was a little surprised to see me, but at least he had the guts to talk to me.

454

00:34:53,000 --> 00:34:55,000

Not like some of these guys.

455

00:34:55,000 --> 00:34:58,000

That's a strange place out there, Plum Island.

456

00:34:58,000 --> 00:35:00,000

I got chased around by the Coast Guard.

457

00:35:00,000 --> 00:35:03,000

I got chased around and shadowed by Homeland Security.

458

00:35:03,000 --> 00:35:05,000

Does that island concern you?

459

00:35:05,000 --> 00:35:09,000

Well, I think there was a period of time where I was very concerned,

460

00:35:09,000 --> 00:35:14,000

because I felt that there was not a sufficient investment in securing the island.

461

00:35:14,000 --> 00:35:19,000

So part of what you encountered, I think, was an increased level of security for the island.

462

00:35:19,000 --> 00:35:22,000

None of the fishing boats would take us out there,

463

00:35:22,000 --> 00:35:27,000

because of fear of retribution from Homeland Security, which I found horrible,

464

00:35:27,000 --> 00:35:33,000

that Homeland Security rules by threats, and rules by intimidation.

465

00:35:33,000 --> 00:35:38,000

I have to tell you, I have never heard any suggestion of threat or intimidation.

466

00:35:38,000 --> 00:35:39,000

I just have not.

467

00:35:39,000 --> 00:35:41,000

Well, I'm giving you your first one then.

468

00:35:42,000 --> 00:35:46,000

What concerned me the most about it was when I read the history of it,

469

00:35:46,000 --> 00:35:51,000

and I saw who the godfather is of Plum Island, Eric Traub,

470

00:35:51,000 --> 00:35:57,000

who was a Nazi right under Himmler that many people think probably should have stood trial at Nuremberg,

471

00:35:57,000 --> 00:36:04,000

but his expertise is attempting to create biological warfare using ticks and mosquitoes to spread them.

472

00:36:04,000 --> 00:36:07,000

That doesn't bother you that this guy came there?

473

00:36:07,000 --> 00:36:11,000

If that was what was going on there, if I was convinced that that was what was going on there,

474

00:36:11,000 --> 00:36:15,000

that would bother me, but I don't believe that that's what's going on there.

475

00:36:15,000 --> 00:36:21,000

So you're comfortable and don't believe in the conspiracy that Lyme disease originated there,

476

00:36:21,000 --> 00:36:24,000

because it started in Lyme, Connecticut, which is right across the water?

477

00:36:24,000 --> 00:36:25,000

I do not accept that.

478

00:36:25,000 --> 00:36:26,000

You don't accept that?

479

00:36:26,000 --> 00:36:27,000

I do not.

480

00:36:27,000 --> 00:36:29,000

What accomplishments have they got out of there?

481

00:36:29,000 --> 00:36:34,000

Well, they have conducted research that has helped us.

482

00:36:34,000 --> 00:36:38,000

What has been achieved? I've heard nothing.

483

00:36:38,000 --> 00:36:42,000

Are you angry that there's a possibility it could move to Kansas?

484

00:36:42,000 --> 00:36:45,000

I wouldn't use the word angry. I am troubled by that,

485

00:36:45,000 --> 00:36:51,000

and in fact I have been working to try to keep the facility open on Plum Island.

486

00:36:51,000 --> 00:36:56,000

Aren't you concerned though that if something could go wrong at this place and what the results of it could be?

487

00:36:56,000 --> 00:37:03,000

Plum Island is so-called zoonotic diseases are not studied at Plum Island.

488

00:37:03,000 --> 00:37:07,000

Diseases that are animal-born that can spread to humans.

489

00:37:07,000 --> 00:37:12,000

The only diseases that are studied at Plum Island are animal-born diseases that do not spread.

490

00:37:12,000 --> 00:37:14,000

And you know this absolutely.

491

00:37:14,000 --> 00:37:16,000

I accept what I've been told.

492

00:37:16,000 --> 00:37:17,000

Okay.

493

00:37:21,000 --> 00:37:24,000

I guess that's the difference between him and me.

494

00:37:24,000 --> 00:37:28,000

I don't just accept what I've been told.

495

00:37:28,000 --> 00:37:31,000

There was someone else I wanted to find anyway.

496

00:37:31,000 --> 00:37:34,000

A guy who knows Plum Island firsthand.

497

00:37:34,000 --> 00:37:39,000

The guy who tells people like Congressman Bishop things they accept.

498
