Originally, this suspicious activity reporting program was directed at law enforcement.

So at least they had some training in the law.

142

But now they're actually public programs where they put out videos that show planes crashing into towers and say you can prevent this by reporting your neighbors.

What's happened when you have gone to investigate these fusion centers?

144

At the Ohio fusion center, we were met with about four very big armed guards when we went in there simply to deliver an open records request.

145

Yeah, this one's really scary. This is the Arizona fusion center and we interviewed this woman right here and she actually informed us that they run organizers of protests.

I asked her if I were to organize a rally, would she run my name through the fusion center databases?

She said yes. So that's legitimate. First amendment activity.

150

With a lot of this collection of this suspicious activity reporting, the government takes what they think is a pattern or a profile and they apply that to you.

To me, Mike, that's as anti-American as you can get.

152

Right, and it creates a huge chilling effect where people think I don't want to be involved in politics because it might be spied on.

Somebody might suggest that I could be a terrorist because I'm involved with this group.

154

Profiling anybody and everybody who disagrees with Big Brother.

155

I knew the next step. Only I was hoping I was wrong.

156

Is this a step towards martial law?

157

Certainly the involvement of the military in these fusion centers is something that's very concerning to us.

Martial law. I'd seen that in the Philippines. The military moving in and taking over our communities.

159

Coming up, Jesse Ventura goes up against a real life monster. The monster fusion center that's watching you.

What the gu- hopefully.

Fusion Center means that they take all kinds of pieces of information and fuse them together.

It may or may not be intelligence.

It also appears to me to be very ripe for abuse.

This technology that you're putting together, how easy could that be used against American citizens?

We don't watch people.

193

We do watch trends.

194

But aren't trends people?

195

Not necessarily.

00:17:34,000 --> 00:17:35,000

But they could be.

197

00:17:35,000 --> 00:17:36,000

They could be.

198

00:17:36,000 --> 00:17:46,000

We had an occasion to study the Fusion Center in Missouri, and it came out that they were focusing in on people with Ron Paul stickers on their cars.

I mean, it even showed up conspiracy theorists.

Governor, I need to talk to you right away.

329

Any kind of military base can be converted into a camp.

331

The first thing that you need is a secured perimeter,

a fence with barbed wire portion turned inward to keep people in

instead of keep people out.

Some type of a guard tower, some type of an airfield,

I mean I've never seen a residential center that has two sets of fences go around.

366

It looks identical to a prison to me.

367

Well, the reason I'm here is just to see what I can do for you today and...

Well you can answer my questions.

Why does it look like a prison if it's a...

370

And I've never come to a residential center that has its front doors locked

371

and you can't walk in and talk to a receptionist.

372

Well the reason for that is to protect the privacy of the residents inside.

373

And why do they need protection?

374

Well, I tell you what I can do for you, sir.

I'm more than happy to forward all your questions to our folks at ICE.

Well, who in the hell has a preneed for this many coffins?

433

00:33:04,000 --> 00:33:08,000

Unless they're planning a massacre.

434

00:33:08,000 --> 00:33:11,000

If they had to get rid of people or dissidents or whatever,

435

00:33:11,000 --> 00:33:15,000

they certainly got the caskets for it, don't they?

436

00:33:15,000 --> 00:33:17,000

What would their argument be, though?

437

The place it makes these boxes used to be a research

438

and development arm of Hercules Incorporated.

439

Hercules is a major defense contractor with ties to Halibur.

The feds gave \$385 million to a Haliburton subsidiary

441

It seems everything that I'm investigating,

443

the trail seems to lead to Haliburton all the time.

444

Exactly, Governor. The admitted Homeland Security contracts

445

00:33:46,000 --> 00:33:48,000

with those camp centers.

446

00:33:48,000 --> 00:33:51,000

That's even been in mainstream news. It's Haliburton.

447

It always goes back to Haliburton.

448

But it doesn't end there.

449

These detention centers and camps are run by FEMA.
