This is the event that inspired my work with conspiracies. This is why I always question authority. This is where it happened.

There's the turn in the road where the motorcade slowed down as Kennedy's convertible approached.

That's where the conspiracy theories were born.

And that's Bill Newman. He was standing right there on that terrible day.

151

Bill may be alive today because he slipped through the cracks.

153

Well Bill, this is about the spot right here that you and your family were standing at?

154

That's correct. My wife, Gail, and my two children, Bill, who was four at the time and Clayton, who was two.

President Kennedy came down just about the center lane?

The side of President Kennedy's head blew off. You could see the brain matter and the blood fly up.

Mrs. Kennedy, she screamed out, oh my God, no, they shot Jack.

I turned to Gail and I said, that's it, hit the ground and we threw our children down and covered them on the ground.

I thought the shot had come from directly behind.

164

Directly behind?

Shot came from behind.

Did you see anything in the book depository building or anything?

167

No, no, I mean, I had no reason to look at the book depository.

I read the report you interviewed by the FBI, a one-page report.

Your wife about what, two-thirds of a page report?

I have it. There's yours and there's your wife.

That was the only, I would say, the official contact that we had with any authorities.

But before he died, Commission member Gerald Ford admitted that the CIA had destroyed or withheld critical evidence.

The Warren Commission didn't even talk to you. Never interviewed.

179

No.

It seems to me like they had the answer before they asked the questions. They already knew the conclusion.

Could be.

The Warren Commission's lone gunman theory relies on something called the magic bullet.

Warren Commission staffer Arlen Specter came up with that one.

187

Gerald Ford later admitted that he changed the description of JFK's wounds to make the theory sound more plausible.

You helped the Warren Commission in the cover-up. Good things can happen.

190

So the fatal shot as far as you can say.

Fatal shot came from right there. Remember, Kennedy said went back into the left. Back into the left. All right.

The museum presents the Warren Commission's version of events.

How come we can't ever get into the real shooter nest?

197

Preservation.

198

00:15:40,000 --> 00:15:47,000

The wood floor is the same way it was back then. Even the markings on the floor which are visible on the crime scene photos are still there.

199

Preservation is the only reason that they do that and keep it the way it is.

200

Yeah, see, I have a difficult time with him making these shots.

I think that it's virtually next to impossible. The guy was not a very good shot to begin with because in the military when he only qualifies a marksman, that's the lowest you can be.

Assassination expert Jim Fetzer warned me about the weapon.

The Manlaker Karakana with the bolt action was so difficult that when you side in with the telescopic side after you work the bolt you're thrown off the target and you have to re-side again.

We got the crane. It's supposed to be 190 to recreate the elevation and distance of Oswald's perch.

206

00:16:41,000 --> 00:16:45,000

Those hay bales represent the spots where JFK was hit.

207

Oswald supposedly got off three shots in 6.3 seconds. He had to shoot through trees too and his target was moving.

208

Just for the record, I was an expert marksman in both pistol and rifle. When I was governor of Minnesota, I amazingly still qualified as an expert at 50 years old.

209

Stand by, fire in the hole.
