Hayward sold his shares in his own company on March 17th, weeks before the spill made BP stock plummet.

People who held on to their BP stock lost their shirts.

They didn't do it alone, though. They hadn't helped.

You had Trans Ocean Company also.

Trans Ocean, the biggest offshore drilling contractor in the world.

BP owned the 194 million gallons of crude oil that gushed into the Gulf, but the rig that blew up, they were leasing it from Trans Ocean.

Trans Ocean owned the oil rig, and their stocks that morning of the disaster had opened up in the European stock exchanges with a special put option available to the inside players.

somebody from a distant site can hit a button and it will cause the blowout preventer to engage.

In other countries, it's law that you have to have an acoustic switch.

132

Why isn't it him?

133

00:11:51,000 --> 00:11:56,000

The reason we don't have that in the United States is because lobbyists have thrown so much money into the process,

134

and we had a vice president, Dick Cheney, who gave the oil industry these huge passes on what they had to comply with as far as regulation.

135

One of those things was the acoustic switch.

136

Dick Cheney, the former head of Halliburton.

137

You remember Halliburton purchased the oil spill cleanup company 11 days before the blast.

11 days.

139

What you had is wanting and reckless conduct.

140

Now, that's the equivalent of somebody licking themselves up, jumping in a car and driving through a school zone at 55 miles an hour.

If they kill somebody, they go to prison.

142

Unfortunately, in America, we treat criminals differently.

143

If a criminal is in a three-piece suit and he works for a corporation like BP, they kill people and they get away with it.

144

Back in Louisiana, I was meeting Adam Dillon, a former cop who'd spent 10 years in US Army Special Ops.

145

He was hired by a BP cleanup operation to keep an eye on the spill.

What's wrong? What's going on here?

147

I was recruited to come down here and start working on this oil spill several weeks after it happened,

148

like an observer controller over the entire shoreline operation for Grand Isle.

149

00:13:15,000 --> 00:13:20,000

In a nutshell, you were put in a pretty powerful, responsible position.

150

00:13:20,000 --> 00:13:21,000

Yes.

151

00:13:21,000 --> 00:13:25,000

There was not one bit of oil that hit the shore that I didn't know about.

152

00:13:25,000 --> 00:13:27,000

Why aren't you working for him now?

153

00:13:27,000 --> 00:13:33,000

I found out something of grave importance to these people, and for whatever reason, they needed to keep quiet.

154

00:13:33,000 --> 00:13:35,000

They were afraid of something from me.

155

00:13:36,000 --> 00:13:43,000

While I was learning what Adam Dillon found, Daniel was finding evidence of a wider conspiracy from one of the locals.

156

John Harrison, as property nearby, he says he moved out after BP moved in next door.

157

00:13:51,000 --> 00:13:55,000

Harrison took photos and video of the operations.

158

00:13:55,000 --> 00:13:59,000

You can see, it wasn't just BP who moved in.

159

00:13:59,000 --> 00:14:11,000

It was local police and the US military not working with the company that was gushing all that oil, working for them.

160

00:14:11,000 --> 00:14:14,000

Early on, there was National Guard there also.

161

00:14:14,000 --> 00:14:15,000

And what were they doing?

162

00:14:15,000 --> 00:14:17,000

Doing security on BP staging area.

163

00:14:18,000 --> 00:14:23,000

So what did Adam Dillon find out that was so important?

164

00:14:23,000 --> 00:14:25,000

A cover up.

165

00:14:25,000 --> 00:14:30,000

I was transferred from Grand Isle to fly around in the airplanes all day and spot the oil in the water.

166

00:14:30,000 --> 00:14:31,000

Sure.

167

00:14:31,000 --> 00:14:35,000

I didn't realize the massive scale of this oil spill until I got out there.

168

00:14:35,000 --> 00:14:41,000

For everything we saw on the surface, there was a hundred times more than that under the surface.

169

00:14:42,000 --> 00:14:47,000

And a lot of the numbers just were not adding up with what we were briefing to the media.

170

00:14:47,000 --> 00:14:54,000

I took these pictures to the people with BP that were supposed to be in charge of constantly updating this information.

171

00:14:54,000 --> 00:14:57,000

And within 24 hours of that happening, I was gone.

172

00:14:57,000 --> 00:14:59,000

In other words, fire.

173

00:14:59,000 --> 00:15:00,000

Pretty much.

174

00:15:00,000 --> 00:15:04,000

Adam Dillon knew the cleanup effort was a sham.

175

00:15:04,000 --> 00:15:06,000

But what else did he know?

176

00:15:06,000 --> 00:15:10,000

On that last day, he said his bosses tried to find out.

177

00:15:10,000 --> 00:15:14,000

They took him into a trailer for an exit interview.

178

00:15:14,000 --> 00:15:17,000

It was more like an interrogation.

179

00:15:17,000 --> 00:15:19,000

I've run interrogations.

180

00:15:19,000 --> 00:15:22,000

Not only as a soldier in Iraq, but as a police officer.

181

00:15:22,000 --> 00:15:24,000

I know what an interrogation looks like.

182

00:15:24,000 --> 00:15:26,000

We sat down, they asked me to open my briefcase.

183

00:15:26,000 --> 00:15:29,000

They wanted to copy the hard drive off of my laptop.

184

00:15:29,000 --> 00:15:33,000

They wanted to copy everything, including all my personal contacts off of my iPhone.

185

00:15:33,000 --> 00:15:35,000

Clearly they wanted to intimidate you.

186

00:15:35,000 --> 00:15:37,000

I guess, but they're not going to.

187

00:15:37,000 --> 00:15:38,000

Right.

188

00:15:38,000 --> 00:15:40,000

Well, you know, let's go over to BP.

189

Yeah, let's go check out the command center.

190

00:15:45,000 --> 00:15:48,000

We arrived at the BP command center.

191

00:15:48,000 --> 00:15:51,000

They wouldn't let us in.

192

00:15:52,000 --> 00:15:56,000

You can see now that security guys are starting to hang out by the deputy sheriff over there.

193

Right, checking us out.

194

00:15:58,000 --> 00:16:13,000

I've been in military installations that did not have as much security as this place does.

195

00:16:15,000 --> 00:16:19,000

Before the cops made it over, somebody else did.

196

00:16:19,000 --> 00:16:21,000

A BP exec.

197

00:16:21,000 --> 00:16:23,000

He had an offer.

198

00:16:23,000 --> 00:16:26,000

His bosses wanted to take me for a ride.

199

00:16:26,000 --> 00:16:28,000

A ride into the Gulf.

200

00:16:28,000 --> 00:16:32,000

Sounded fishy, but what the hell?

201

00:16:34,000 --> 00:16:38,000

Coming up is BP poisoning the waters intentionally.

202

00:16:38,000 --> 00:16:41,000

I've got a paper in front of me.

203

00:16:41,000 --> 00:16:47,000

Headline BP gives Fett's middle finger will continue toxic dispersants and Gulf oil spill.

204

00:16:47,000 --> 00:16:53,000

Then, Jesse finds evidence that human victims are already piling up.

205

For close to three months, I've had brown stuff running out of my ears.

And later, it's not only Louisiana and the Gulf.

The depopulation conspiracy targets you.

I came to Louisiana to investigate an oil spill conspiracy.

214

And the guys responsible invite me on a boat ride into the middle of it all.

215

Yeah, I had my suspicions, but I figured it would be worth the risk.

216

First stop was their own little beach.

217

00:18:03,000 --> 00:18:10,000

They were going to show me how well they were cleaning up the spill with a dispersant called Corexit.

218

00:18:10,000 --> 00:18:14,000

But really, Corexit doesn't clean up oil at all.

219

00:18:14,000 --> 00:18:19,000

What it does is break up the slick into little globules.

220

00:18:19,000 --> 00:18:23,000

Smaller balls of oil that sink to the ocean floor.

221

00:18:23,000 --> 00:18:28,000

The oil's still there. You just can't see it.

222

00:18:28,000 --> 00:18:33,000

This is a small tar ball that has washed up. It's mixed with dispersant.

223

00:18:33,000 --> 00:18:38,000

This is just one area that we've been working in. Most of it's been cleaned and that's just a smaller one.

224

00:18:38,000 --> 00:18:42,000

There is some other areas, but that's what we have been cleaning for several months.

225

00:18:42,000 --> 00:18:47,000

Now there's areas where it's obviously way worse than this.

226

00:18:47,000 --> 00:18:51,000

Yes, as the current comes in and out, you don't ever know.

227

00:18:51,000 --> 00:18:55,000

How long do you think this could go on for? I mean, this could be going on for years.

228

00:18:55,000 --> 00:18:59,000

I don't think so. I think Mother Nature in its time is going to take care of it.

229

00:18:59,000 --> 00:19:05,000

Sounds like they're positioning themselves to get off the hook by blaming Mother Nature.

230

00:19:05,000 --> 00:19:10,000

Now, this stuff you put on it, what was that called again?

231

00:19:10,000 --> 00:19:12,000

It was some type of dispersant.

232

00:19:12,000 --> 00:19:13,000

The dispersant?

233

00:19:13,000 --> 00:19:16,000

Right. I'm not sure what the chemical makeup was.

234

Is the dispersant dangerous?

235

00:19:18,000 --> 00:19:20,000

I couldn't tell you.

236

00:19:20,000 --> 00:19:24,000

He couldn't tell me? This guy must be living under a rock.

237

00:19:24,000 --> 00:19:30,000

Back in Grand Isle, Daniel was finding out that everybody knew about the dangers of Corexit.

238

00:19:30,000 --> 00:19:32,000

Do you have any experience with that?

239

00:19:32,000 --> 00:19:33,000

Corexit stuff.

240

00:19:33,000 --> 00:19:38,000

I've been out there in the middle of it for the last 100 days and I've been sick the whole time.

241
