It sounded like just this enormous piece of steel just rubbing across the ground, almost like a...

What is that?

I hope the video is picking it up.

We need the best technology to dive deep into the waveform

323

and give us an analysis and compare it to other things

This is Justin's recording.

It's the full sound spectrum of what the phone recorded.

that's our sound right there, the unknown sound.

Utilizing advanced algorithms,

Ed Software isolates the audio waves

335

to create a digital fingerprint called a spectrogram.

So we got rid of the sounds that are distracting to your ear

This is the noise.

What is it?

Now the video that we have from the stadium,

So this is the stadium recording without the high frequencies.

And when we look at the other recording,

it's the same frequency.

We see the same frequency,

354

which is one of the reasons why I believe they're the same.

The spectrogram clearly shows that these two sounds,

356

the one at the stadium and the one that Justin recorded,

That's a big deal.

There's obviously something coming from the night sky

360

362

anything that moves to create sound.

Ed runs the spectrogram of the unknown sound

364

through a database of 10,000 spectrograms

365

of natural and man-made sounds from Earth.

366

Planes, ambulance, fighter jets.

367

00:20:58,000 --> 00:21:00,000

To determine if there is a match.

368

Wind is the only thing that I discovered that's similar.

369

But then we can see that wind oscillates.

370

It goes up and down in tonality.

371

When we look at our sound,

372

it's very narrow and very consistent along the bottom,

This is why I believe it's not wind.

376

So, do you have any idea basically what it is?

377

It doesn't sound like anything that I've experienced before.

In how many years?

on August 22, 2011.

A forensic audiologist of decades of experience,

400

certifying that he has never heard anything

401

either man-made or natural,

402

00:22:40,000 --> 00:22:43,000

create this kind of sound.

403

00:22:43,000 --> 00:22:44,000

This is pretty exciting.

404

00:22:44,000 --> 00:22:46,000

We've shown through audiopharynx

405

00:22:46,000 --> 00:22:49,000

that this is a sound without a natural explanation.

406

This could be evidence that something out of this earth

407

00:22:52,000 --> 00:22:54,000

is moving through our skies.

408

Another thing, we got an update from Sarah and Nick in the field.

409

They just interviewed Margie Blake.

410

She claims to have seen strange objects in the sky

I'd probably say 50 to 60 total.

They were coming down in groups, like circling each other,

419

and they shot to the north and just totally disappeared.

All in a cluster in one location in Virginia.

439

Where is that?

What do we know about that town?

442

Not a very big town, about 20,000 people.

443

Shenandoah Valley, old coal mining town.

444

Look, I've got social media hits from people in this area.

445

Everyone come meet me and Abby in Waynesboro.

There's UFOs in the sky right now.

This guy, Andrew Santiago.

Anyone else see these lights above town?

449

Why do we have eight sightings in a town of 20,000 people?

We just went up the whole eastern seaboard.

There's tons of lots more popular cities than that.

Very strange, and to have them all in this same moment,

Are these sightings in the small town of Virginia connected to this larger pattern

519

And his description is very similar to what we heard in Florida.

Now we have a clear connection here.

For whatever reason, almost all roads lead to Waynesboro.

are on the ground in Waynesboro, Virginia, where a pattern of strange sounds and sightings

530

00:28:34,000 --> 00:28:40,000

on August 22, 2011 has led them to this small town in the Shenandoah Valley.

531

Why is it that we have a series of both audio and visual sightings

532

00:28:44,000 --> 00:28:47,000

all on the same day, all ending up here?

533

00:28:47,000 --> 00:28:50,000

What the hell is going on in Waynesboro that's causing this to happen?

534

00:28:50,000 --> 00:28:53,000

The team has been granted access to the city archives,

535

00:28:53,000 --> 00:28:58,000

which houses local documents from the last 200 years.

536

00:28:58,000 --> 00:29:01,000

We're all used to just getting online and Googling and finding things out.

537

But in small towns like this, actually there might be a wealth of information that's not online.

538

Look at this.

Close encounters of the local kind.

540

The Shenandoah Valley is no stranger to close encounters of the unexplained kind.

541

At least 25 UFO sightings in the valley between November 1964 and January 1965

542

00:29:23,000 --> 00:29:25,000

were investigated by the Air Force.

543

00:29:25,000 --> 00:29:27,000

25 sightings between 1964 and 1965.

544

00:29:27,000 --> 00:29:29,000

Yeah, so that won essentially a year time span.

545

00:29:29,000 --> 00:29:31,000

Wow, take a look at this one.

546

00:29:31,000 --> 00:29:35,000

Seven high school students and a school bus driver have reported sighting

547

00:29:35,000 --> 00:29:39,000

as shapeless white object in the sky north of Waynesboro.

548

00:29:39,000 --> 00:29:43,000

It appears that there's been decades of sightings here in Waynesboro.

549

00:29:43,000 --> 00:29:46,000

Look at this one, local gunsmith encounters UFO.

550

00:29:46,000 --> 00:29:49,000

It's not just this one isolated incident in modern times,

551

00:29:49,000 --> 00:29:51,000

it actually spans back to the 1960s.

552

00:29:51,000 --> 00:29:54,000

I'm surprised there's just so many in this small area too.

553

I mean, this is not a heavily populated area now, especially back in, you know, the 60s.

554

So what I recommend we do is you start going through all these articles again deliberately

555

and start plotting them and seeing if we can develop a pattern.

Yeah, let's just start with these.

It says it was 1965.

559

Just east of Stanton.

561
