So our objective here to determine once and for all what crashed here.

Prior to the crash incident, the area was populated by a dense hardwood forest.

Jorge, what's your first impression of this place?

Is there someone else we can talk to that might know anything about that day?

It was a massive crash. Thousands of people saw it.

The chief of Salta Police, Adolfo Torres, meets with the team.

98

We were hoping that you guys had some reporting regarding a huge crash of this object.

Something about the incident, I don't know, it wasn't our case,

100

00:05:54,000 --> 00:05:56,000

it wasn't our investigation.

Here in the police station, the police didn't have any records.

102

You're saying that the local police, you guys had no role in the security

103

Officially, the police didn't participate in the incident.

The local police claim that they have no records of this event

108

and took over the investigation, which is really confusing.

Like, who was it? Who was running the show?

111

Is there anybody else that we can talk to that might perhaps know anything about that date?

There's somebody commented to him off the record,

Yeah, man. Looks like this is the place.

Tony is a 35-year veteran commercial pilot

123

with intimate knowledge and understanding of Chilean airspace.

124

00:07:10,000 --> 00:07:11,000

Good day.

125

How are you?

126

00:07:12,000 --> 00:07:13,000

How are you?

Hey.

128

Tony, where were you the day of the UFO crash in 1995?

129

141

This possible seismic activity, right?

The whole area is on lockdown, basically?

164

Were you able to see who was blocking these roads,

166

what they looked like, anything like that?

167

There were civilians.

168

There were trucks, 4x4.

169

There were uniformed people with black uniforms.

170

So there were some strangers dressed as civilians

171

and others that came in black 4x4s, all dressed in black.

172

Some of these people spoke a little Spanish,

but they were foreigners

174

and they were blocking all the access to that area.

Unidentified men in black that don't seem Argentinian,

177

179

Somebody didn't want people to see that site.

180

Somebody wanted to put a lid on this thing.

181

Who was that?

182

What were they trying to hide?

183

Elemental analysis of the SOE was performed

Iron, nickel, camsite, tynite,

196

or perhaps the best indicator, shocked quartz.

The analyzed samples were void of any of these particulates.

In other words, conclusion is that was not a meteorite.

00:11:43,000 --> 00:11:46,000

and then the Argentine government says,

217

in no uncertain terms, that this is a meteorite,

218

and scientific analysis of the site says it is not a meteorite.

219

The Link Analysis software identifies a news article

253

It sees a really bright object.

Upon removing the surface soil, Johnson noticed

How to write white substance of some kind.

Now soil doesn't just change like that.

For you, it was best just to cover it up and forget about it.

393

I feel like this incident has really affected your entire life.

395

The soil had a strange white substance under the affected area.

Heat source? White substance.

440

Could a UFO have touched down here in Bariloche

441

and then crashed at Salta 48 hours later?

442

465

the chief of the airport control tower

466

at the time of the 1995 incident.

467

Daniel, what do you know about the reported UFO landing back in 95?

468

Marcas, la has visto mucho la atención,

Is that right?

The team starts with a pH test to find the soil's pH level.

Normal soil in Kansas ranges from 5.5 to 7.

Mike and Dr. Livingston examine a recently

declassified Lithuanian government file.

Two Lithuanian police officers see a spherical object

729

This is something very difficult to recreate in the lab,

730

but we do see it in the wild.

731

Yeah, but a highly trained military unit

732

does not engage meteorological phenomena.

where a team of scientists from Kansas State University

executed a series of lab tests

742

on soil from the location where an eyewitness, Ron Johnson,

saw UFO touch down,

leaving behind a strange ring in the ground.

745

This is the soil taken from that ring.

746

In 1980, a bright light in the sky looked like a star,

791

792

2016, we saw a bright light move above the trees.

793

Pull up this one.

794

795

2008, something brighter than the sun,

796

797

like they do when a bad storm comes in.

798

Hardly got a good view of it,

799

but this thing wasn't much bigger than a car.

800

That's actually about the same size.
